Making calls

In idle mode, key in the area code, the phone number and press to make a call.

Answering calls

Press or (Accept) to answer a call. Alternatively, simply open the phone cover to answer a call if the handset cover is closed (if "Flip answer" is activated).

Terminating calls

Press or [M] (End) to end the active call. Alternatively, simply close the phone cover to end.

Refusing calls

Press or (Reject) or simply close the handset cover to refuse an

incoming call.

Emergency calls

In idle mode, key in 112 and press to contact the emergency services center.

Clear screen

Press and hold to clear an editing entry.

Adjusting the earpiece volume

You can adjust the earpiece volume when calling using (louder) or (lower) to increase or decrease the earpiece volume.


Add new phone number
