MODEL DIFFERENCE LETTER, IC: 3724B-DH7BT, FCC ID BXZDH7BT

This letter is to explain the differences between the different variants of Ascom DH7 handsets with the following model numbers:

For Brand: The branding print on the plastic is different.

For Features:

1. DH7-xAxx will have the components for Bluetooth but not IR receiver mounted on the PCB. Mini messaging function, 12 characters.
2. DH7-xBxx will have the components for Bluetooth but not IR-receiver mounted on the PCB. Sending/receiving messages (SMS)
3. DH7-xDxx will have the components for Bluetooth and IR receiver mounted on the PCB

The basic DH7 model (DH7) (FCC ID: BXZDH7 and IC: 3724B-DH7) is electrically and mechanically identical to the DH7 models with BT module (DH7BT) (FCC ID: BXZDH7BT and IC: 3724B-DH7BT). The PCB and all components are identical, the only difference is that the BT module is not installed on the PCB of the basic DH7 model and that some DH7BT models have an additional IR receiver.

All plastic parts and physical dimensions are identical between all DH7 and all DH7BT models.
