> specified in FCC15.21. Please revise the user manual.
>
> Question #2: The user manual indicates that "When you connect a standard
> FireWire cable or mini-USB cable between your computer and iPod mini,
> PodFreq mini acts as a dock substitute. " This device is categorized as PC
> and PC peripheral device, FCC DoC or FCC certification is required. If the
> device is under DoC scheme, please add FCC DoC logo on the FCC ID label format.
> If it is to be certified, please file a separate application.
>
> Question #3: The test report says the device is battery powered only,
> which is not true. The user manual indicates the device has no battery or power
> cord, it is powered by iPod Mini. Please update the test report.
> Furthermore, iPod Mini can be powered by battery or Firewire cable/USB
> cable, also the user manual indicates that "you can even operate your iPod
> mini when PodFreq mini is connected to your computer by a standard Firewire
> cable/USB cable." please provide power line conducted emission test data.
>
> Question #4: The test setup photos show radiated emission test was done when
> the device was connected to a laptop. Please verify if the device with iPod

> Mini, when not connected with laptop, has been investigated for radiated
> emission. Please update the report to include both configurations. You can
> report the data of worse case, though.
>
> Question #5: The test report does not show Bandwidth test was done with
> maximum input signal and user controls adjusted to maximize emission. Please
> add description in the test report as how to maximize input signal and user
> controls during bandwidth test.
