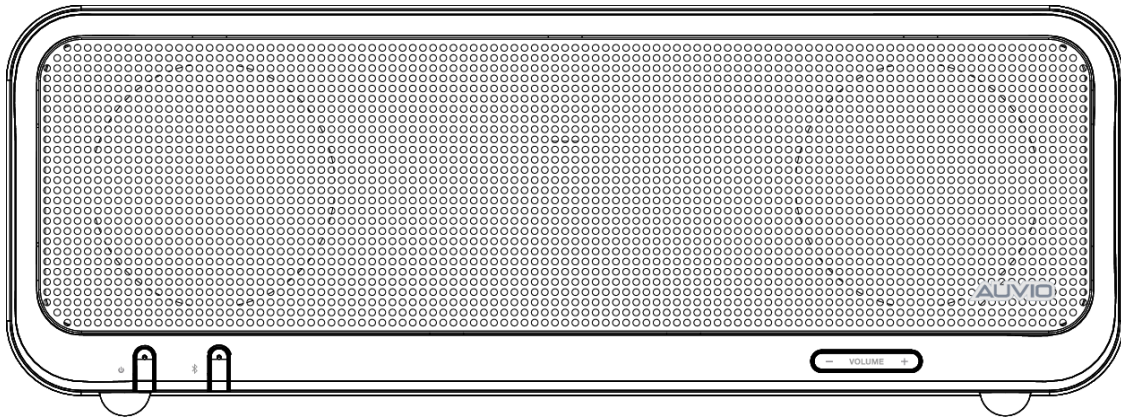

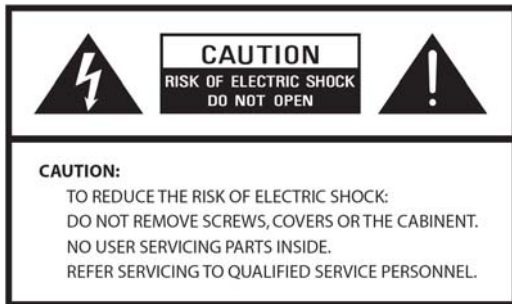

# Safety Information





# Introduction

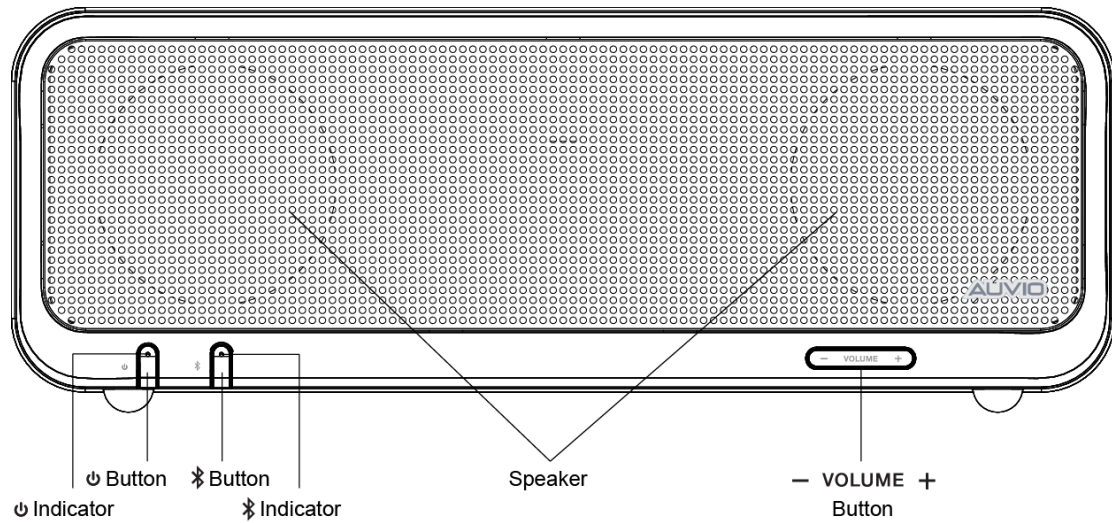

## Package content

What you can find inside of your package:

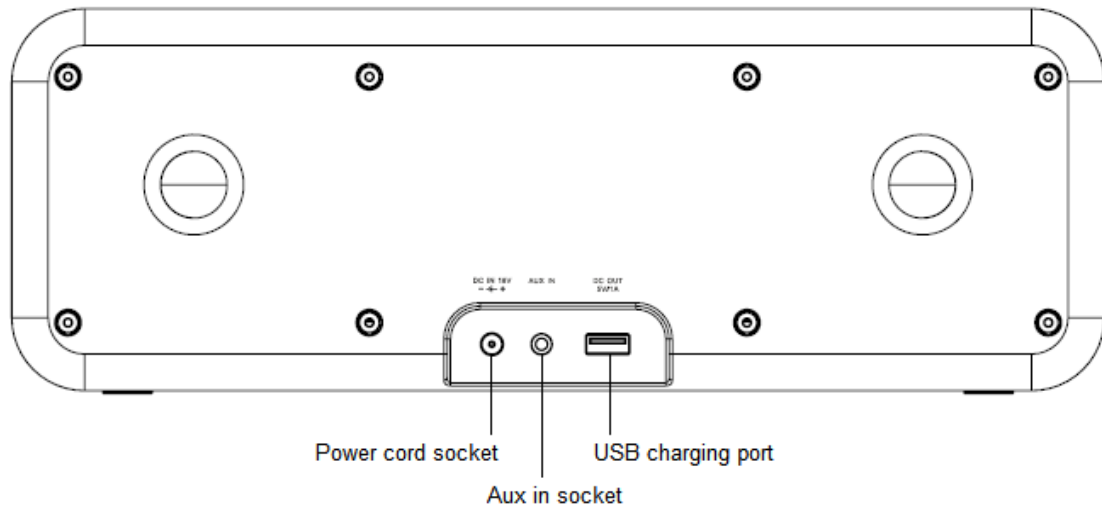

⏻ Button	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Press to turn on speaker.</li> <li>Press again to switch speaker into standby mode.</li> </ul>
📶 Button	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Press and hold to disconnect Bluetooth connection.</li> </ul>
 Button	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Press to adjust volume level.</li> </ul>
⏻ Indicator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Illuminate in Red light indicates speaker is in standby mode.</li> <li>Red light off indicates speaker is turned on.</li> <li>Flash 2s in Red light and then off indicates speaker is in Aux mode.</li> </ul>
📶 Indicator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Flash in Red and Blue light means speaker is pairing with a Bluetooth device or connecting with a paired Bluetooth device.</li> <li>Flash once for 3s in Blue light indicates speaker is connected with a Bluetooth device.</li> </ul>

Items	Remark:
Power cord socket:	Connect to DC adaptor.
AUX IN socket:	It is for connecting the audio cable.
USB charging port	Output a 5V voltage for charging your personal devices such as your smart phone.

# Bluetooth Mode


## Turning on


1. Before using your new Bluetooth Speaker the first time, you should connect adapter to your speaker.
2. Press  **Button** to switch on. The  **Indicator** flashing fast in Blue light and waiting for pairing with a Bluetooth device or connecting to a paired Bluetooth device.

## Pairing with Bluetooth devices


Pairing occurs when two Bluetooth devices communicate with each other and establish a connection. A record of information about this connection is then stored in the memory of each device. Once you pair a device with the Speaker, you should not have to pair it again.

### To begin pairing with a Bluetooth device

1. Turn on your Bluetooth device.
2. Activate your Bluetooth device and select the search mode.
3. Press  **Button** on Speaker to enable pairing.
4. From the Bluetooth device list, select the device "HBT2000W".
5. If your device asks for a password, enter digits 0000 (four zeros) and press OK. Some devices also ask you to accept the connection.

Your Bluetooth device indicates when pairing is complete. The Speaker indicates pairing is complete when the  **Indicator** flash slow in Blue light.


### To pair additional devices

 **Note:** when you have paired Speaker with a Bluetooth device and want to use another device instead, please disable the Bluetooth function of your previous Bluetooth device.

Follow "To begin pairing with a Bluetooth device" steps 1-5.

# Aux in Mode

You can use another audio device with your Speaker. This requires using an audio cable with a 3.5mm plug on one end to connect with the Aux input on the Speaker system.

1. Plug the 3.5mm audio cable from the audio device into the Aux connector on the back of the Speaker.
2. Your Speaker will automatically shift to Aux in mode. The  **Indicator** will flash 2s in Red light and then off.
3. To gain optimal volume levels, adjusting the output volume level on both the source device and the Speaker itself are recommended.



# Troubleshooting

Problem	What to do
Speaker will not turn on	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Make sure your system is connected to a working mains outlet.</li> </ul>
Paired Bluetooth device will not connect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If your device requires a passkey, make sure the one you entered was correct.</li> <li>● Turn the Speaker off and back on.</li> <li>● Remove the Speaker from the pairing list on your Bluetooth device pairing list. Then pair the device and the Speaker again.</li> </ul>
Speaker indicates a connection, but is not playing music	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Turn off or disable Bluetooth on all other paired devices nearby and reconnect the device you want to hear.</li> <li>● Turn the Speaker off and back on.</li> </ul>
Cannot pair the Speaker with my Bluetooth device	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Make sure your Bluetooth device is discoverable.</li> <li>● Your Bluetooth device may be out of range – try moving it closer to the Speaker.</li> <li>● Make sure your Bluetooth device supports the transfer of audio.</li> <li>● Move your Bluetooth device and/or Speaker away from other devices that generate electromagnetic interference.</li> <li>● If possible, turn off all other nearby Bluetooth devices or disable their Bluetooth functionality.</li> <li>● Turn the Speaker off and back on.</li> </ul>
No audio from a Bluetooth device	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Make sure your Speaker is not muted, and the volume is up.</li> <li>● Make sure your Bluetooth device is playing audio, and the volume is up.</li> <li>● Your Bluetooth device may be out of range – try moving it closer to the Speaker.</li> <li>● Turn the Speaker off and back on.</li> </ul>
No audio from the AUX source	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Make sure your connected device is on and playing.</li> <li>● Make sure your Speaker is in Aux in mode.</li> <li>● Make sure the 3.5mm plug is fully inserted into the Speaker.</li> </ul>
