

- 1. Read these instructions.

- 5. Do not use this apparatus near water.
- 6. Clean only with dry cloth. For stubborn stains, use a soft cloth dampened with a weak solution of mild detergent and water. Dry the apparatus immediately afterwards with a clean cloth. Do not use abrasive clothes, thinners, alcohol, or other chemical solvents, because they may damage the finish or remove the panel lettering.
- 7.Do not block any ventilation openings. The ventilation shall not be impeded by covering the ventilation openings with items, such as newspapers, table clothes, curtains, etc.
- 8.Do not install near any heat source such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.

- 9. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding - type plug. a polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong are provided for your safety. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.
- 10. The optimum operating temperature is 0° C ~ 40° C.
- 11. The optimum humidity is 30%~80%.
- 12. Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus. If the power cord is damaged, it must be repaired by a qualified repairer.
- Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- 14. Use only with the cart, stand, tripod, bracket or table specified by the manufacturer, or sold with the apparatus. When a cart is used, use caution when moving the cart/apparatus combination to avoid injury from tip-over.





- 15. Unplug this apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.
- 16. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. - 17. The apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the apparatus.
- 18. The mains plug or an appliance coupler is used as the disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily operable.

Charge









1 When Flashing RED, OYSTER requires charging.

2 Insert the DC jack into the rear of your OYSTER.

3 A YELLOW Light indicates OYSTER is charging.

4 A GREEN light indicates that OYSTER is charged.

Power, Pair & Play

1 Activate Bluetooth on the device you wish to connect.


2 Press the ON•OFF button to switch on your OYSTER.

3 The BLUE light blinks to show it is in pairing mode. Select OYSTER in the Bluetooth settings of your device.

4 Once paired it will connect automatically and the blue light will turn solid. 5 When connected, OYSTER will appear in your device list and you are ready to PLAY. You can only connect OYSTER to one device at the same time.



Line In



1 Insert the 3.5mm cable supplied into the rear of the device you are connecting and the other end into the AUX IN at the rear of OYSTER. Press 2 SOURCE until the LED indicator turns 3 WHITE.

Receiving a Call



You can accept an incoming the call 1 using your OYSTER by pressing the 2 button. Press the 2 button to hang up.
