After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

1) The Users Manual Contains the following information:

## Regulatory Information

This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules and Industry Canada RSS-210. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.

 Tested to comply with FCC standards. For home and office use. Model number: Wireless Optical Desktop receiver (all models), <u>FCC IDs C3KKB9 and C3KMS9</u>; Wireless Optical Desktop Pro receiver (all models), <u>FCC IDs C3KKB10 and C3KMS9</u>.

This paragraph sounds like the FCC ID's are also being applied to the receiver portion of the device. Are the receivers labeled with the FCC ID Number? The receivers should be labeled only with the proper FCC DoC Labeling (Logo, etc.) and NOT with the FCC ID number. The FCC ID number is applicable only to the keyboard portion. Please adjust the information above so that it is not misleading.

2) The test reports states that 3 samples were provided. It is not clear why 3 samples were tested. Please explain.
