Further to our application for approval of the PAE B3060V2 transceiver please note that equipment provided for sale within the United States will not be capable of operating on 8.33kHz channel spacing nor in the Maritime Band. The 8.33kHz channelling is for European customers and is disabled in hardware.

Similarly, whilst the equipment is capable of operating in the Marine band as shown in the User Guide under option 10, this facility is not available on standard equipment. The guidelines in the User manual only apply if this option has been requested at the time of purchase.

No versions carrying the FCC ID label will support these two functions.
