Dear Mr. Coperich,

The mobile radio in question will only be marked in the USA as a 25kHz version. References to 8.33kHz channel spacing apply to our European customers. Consequently we feel we were incorrect in applying for operation under the emission designator 5K00A3E and would ask that this designator be deleted from our application.

In order to clarify the FCC position we propose to add the following words to the User guide:

Notice for the USA: FCC Statement

This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC rules. Operation is subject to the condition that this device does not cause harmful interference.

This equipment is only licensed for operation on 25kHz channel spacing.
Operation on 8.33 kHz channel spacing is restricted to European customers.

This statement will be added to page ii of the User Guide.

I hope this is acceptable to allow us to proceed.

Please also note we have a parallel application for a complementary receiver under C8LB6100 (EA97191) and these changes apply to this application also.
