#### 2. TEST METHODOLOGY

All calculations were made in accordance with FCC KDB 447498.

### 3. REFERENCES

All measurements were made as documented in test report UL Verification Services Inc. Document 12220680-E1V2 and 12220680-E2V2 for operation in the 2.4 GHz band.

Output power, Duty cycle and Antenna gain data is excerpted from the applicable test reports.

#### 4. FACILITIES AND ACCREDITATION

The test sites and measurement facilities used to collect data are located at 47173 and 47266 Benicia Street, Fremont, California, USA.

#### 5. DEVICE UNDER TEST

The EUT is a Tire Pressure Monitor with radios BLE operating in the frequency range of 2402 to 2480 MHz and ANT+ operating in the frequency range of 2405 to 2475MHz. The user to antenna separation distance is 0mm.

#### 6. MAXIMUM OUTPUT POWER

The maximum output power of the device is declared as the following:

BLE = 0dBm ±1dB; Antenna Gain: -2dBi ANT+ = 0dBm ±1dB; Antenna Gain: -2dBi DATE: June 26 2018

## 7. STANDALONE SAR TEST EXCLUSION CONSIDERATIONS

#### 7.1. **FCC**

SAR test exclusion in accordance with KDB 447498 D01 v06.

The 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100 MHz to 6 GHz at test separation distances ≤ 50 mm are determined by:

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW) / (min. test separation distance, mm)]· $[\sqrt{f(GHz)}] \le 3.0$ , for 1-g SAR and ≤ 7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR, where

- $f_{(GHz)}$  is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz
- Power and distance are rounded to the nearest mW and mm before calculation
- The result is rounded to one decimal place for comparison

This test exclusion is applicable only when the minimum test separation distance is ≤ 50 mm and for transmission frequencies between 100 MHz and 6 GHz. When the minimum test separation distance is < 5 mm, a distance of 5 mm is applied to determine SAR test exclusion.

#### **Conclusion:**

The device operates with a maximum Duty Cycle of 100%. The Calculated Threshold with duty cycle applied is ≤3 for1-g SAR and ≤7 for10-g extremity SAR; therefore, this device qualifies for Standalone SAR test exclusion.
