2. TEST METHODOLOGY

The tests documented in this report were performed in accordance with FCC CFR 47 Part 2, FCC CFR 47 Part 15, ANSI C63.10-2013, KDB 558074 D01 15.247 Meas Guidance v05r02, RSS-GEN Issue 5, and RSS-247 Issue 2.

3. FACILITIES AND ACCREDITATION

The test sites and measurement facilities used to collect data are located at 47173 and 47266 Benicia Street, and 47658 Kato Road, Fremont, California, USA. Line conducted emissions are measured only at the 47173 address. The following table identifies which facilities were utilized for radiated emission measurements documented in this report. 4. CALIBRATION AND UNCERTAINTY

4.1. MEASURING INSTRUMENT CALIBRATION

The measuring equipment utilized to perform the tests documented in this report has been calibrated in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, and is traceable to recognized national standards.

4.2. SAMPLE CALCULATION

5. EQUIPMENT UNDER TEST

5.1. DESCRIPTION OF EUT

The EUT is a Right Extension with BLE and AIREA Radios, powered by CR2032 coin cell battery.

5.2. MAXIMUM OUTPUT POWER

Please refer to UL report # 12292049-E1V2.

The output powers were verified and measured at same or lower power setting compared to the original certification testing level.

5.3. DESCRIPTION OF AVAILABLE ANTENNAS

The radio utilizes a chip antenna type number W3008C, with a maximum gain of 2.2dBi.

5.4. SOFTWARE AND FIRMWARE

The EUT firmware installed during testing was A-1.0.

The test utility software used during testing was Lightblue v2.6.4

5.5. DESCRIPTION OF CLASS II PERMISSIVE CHANGE

The major change filed under Class II Permissive Change application is: Changing enclosure and adding model 00130.

5.6. WORST-CASE CONFIGURATION AND MODE

Radiated band edge, harmonic, and spurious emissions from 1GHz to 18GHz were performed with the EUT was set to transmit at highest power on Low/Middle/High channels.

Radiated emissions below 30MHz, below 1GHz, 18-26GHz and power line conducted emissions were performed with the EUT transmits at the channel with the highest output power as worst-case scenario.

The fundamental of the EUT was investigated in three orthogonal orientations X, Y, Z, it was determined that X orientation was worst-case orientation; therefore, all final radiated testing was performed with the EUT in X orientation.

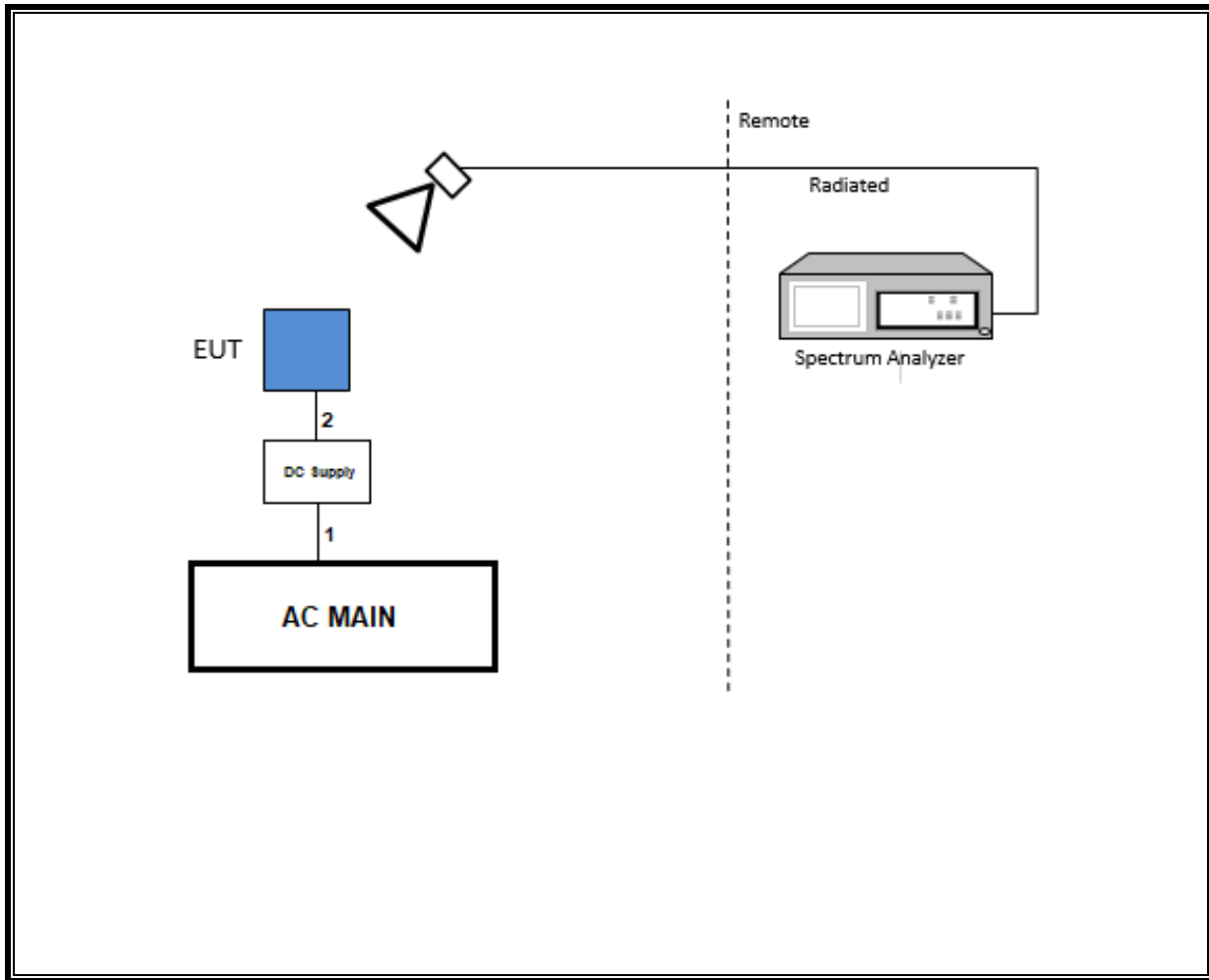

TEST PROCEDURE

The EUT is placed on a non-conducting table 80 cm above the ground plane for measurement below 1GHz; 1.5 m above the ground plane for measurement above 1GHz. The antenna to EUT distance is 3 meters. The EUT is configured in accordance with ANSI C63.10. The EUT is set to transmit in a continuous mode.

For measurements below 1 GHz the resolution bandwidth is set to 100 kHz for peak detection measurements or 120 kHz for quasi-peak detection measurements. Peak detection is used unless otherwise noted as quasi-peak.

For pre-scans above 1 GHz the resolution bandwidth is set to 1 MHz; the video bandwidth is set to 30 KHz for peak measurements.

For final measurements above 1 GHz the resolution bandwidth is set to 1 MHz; the video bandwidth is set to 3 MHz for peak measurements and as applicable for average measurements.

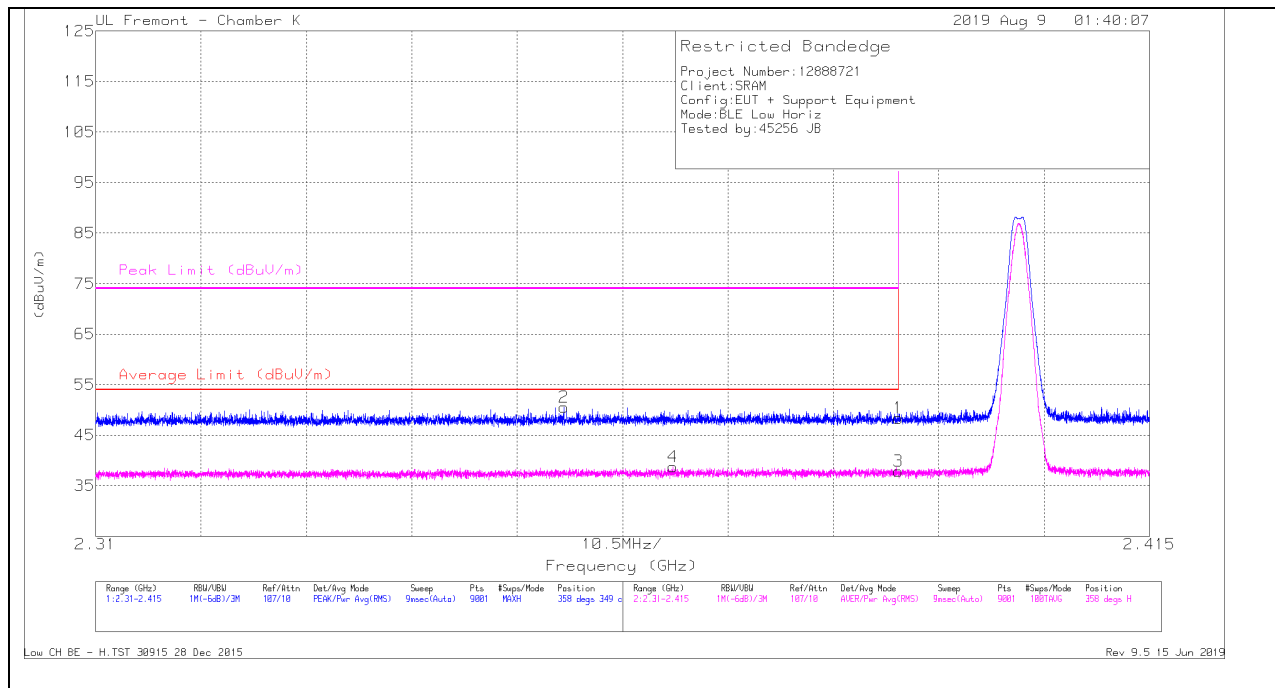
The spectrum from 1 GHz to 18 GHz is investigated with the transmitter set to the lowest, middle, and highest channels in each applicable band. Below 1GHz and above 18GHz emissions, the channel with the highest output power was tested.

The frequency range of interest is monitored at a fixed antenna height and EUT azimuth. The EUT is rotated through 360 degrees to maximize emissions received. The antenna is scanned from 1 to 4 meters above the ground plane to further maximize the emission. Measurements are made with the antenna polarized in both the vertical and the horizontal positions.

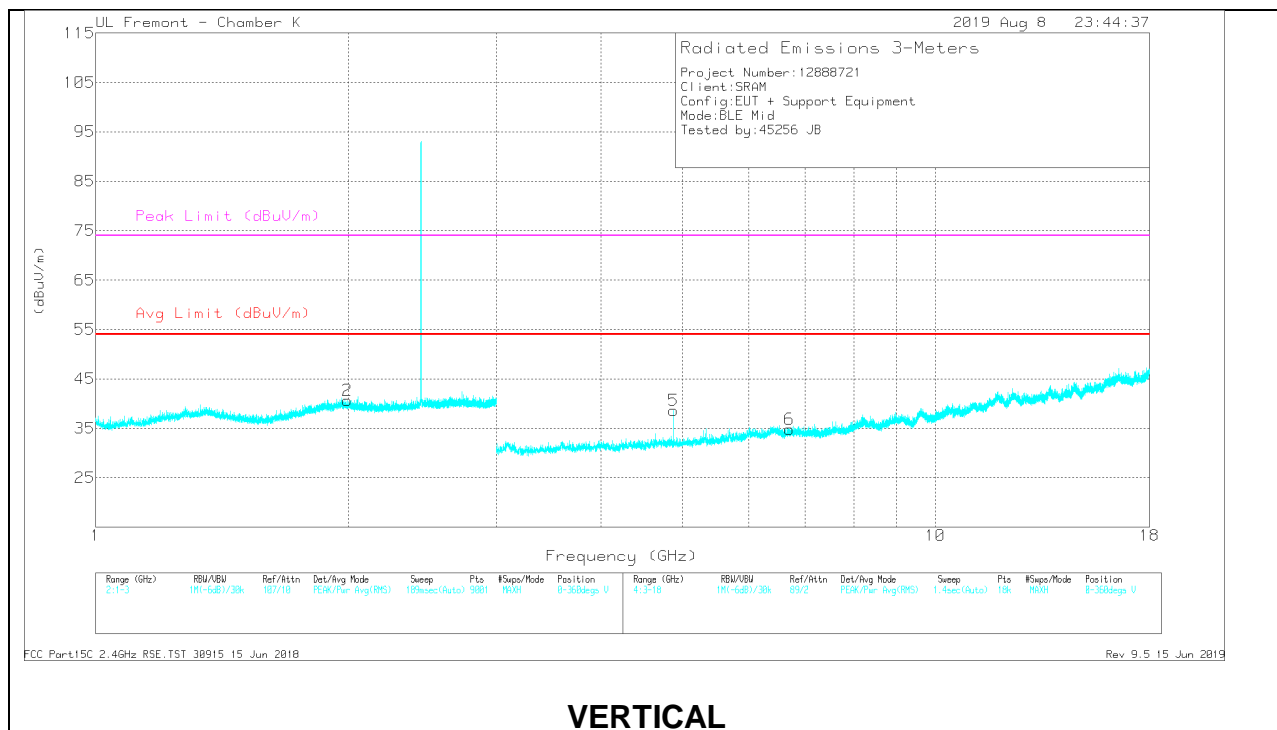

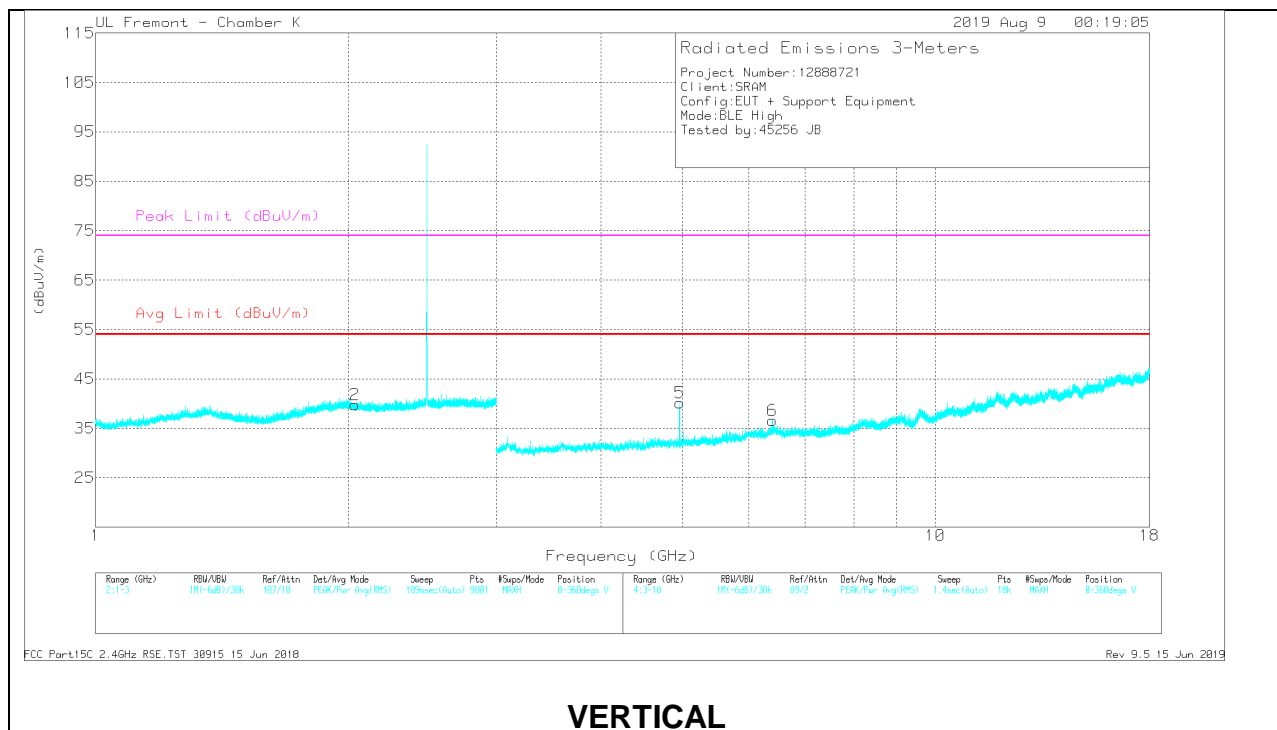

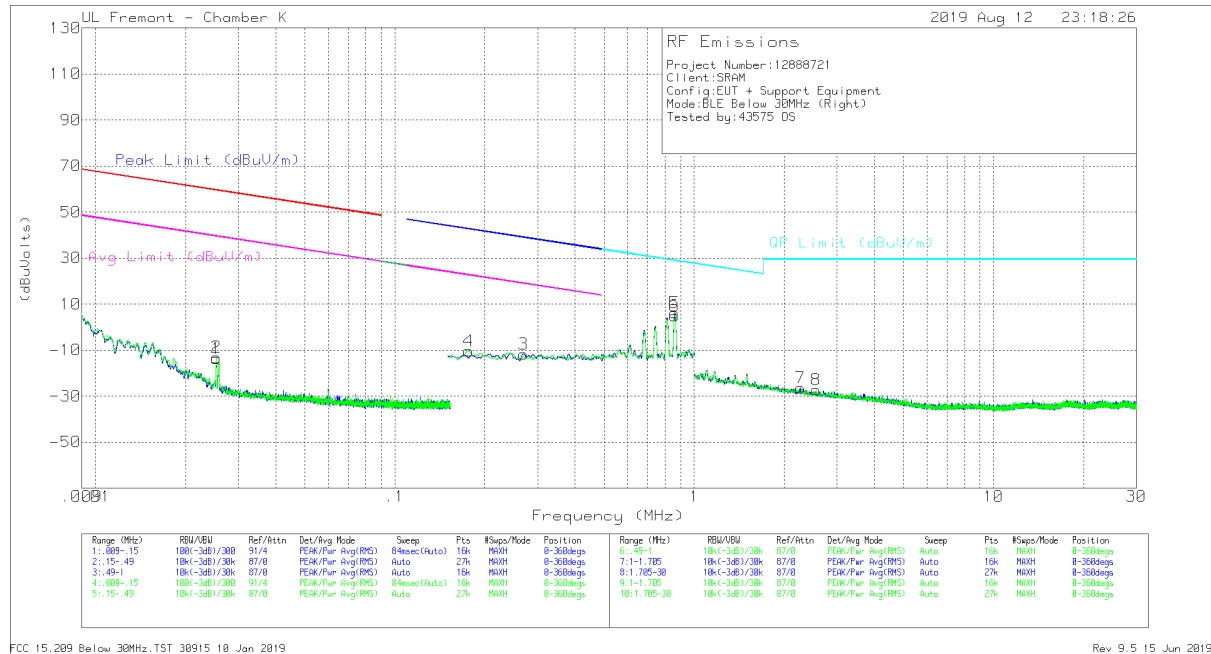

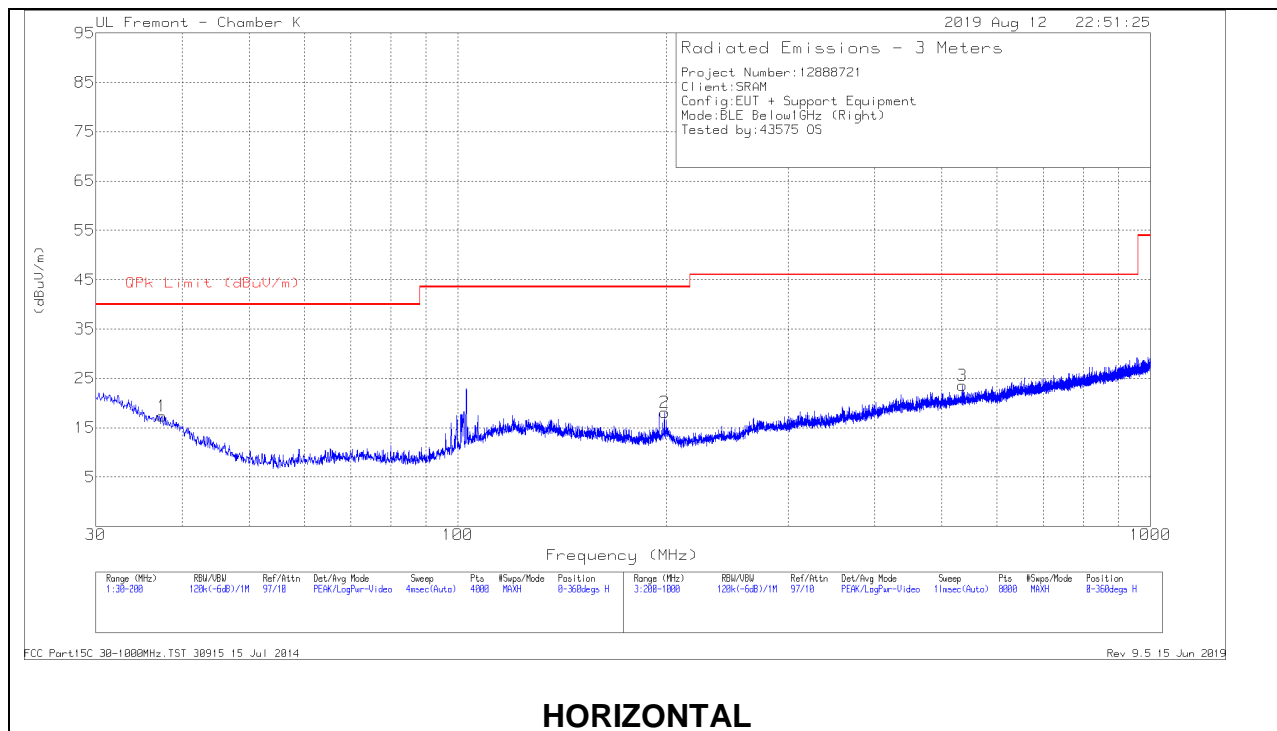

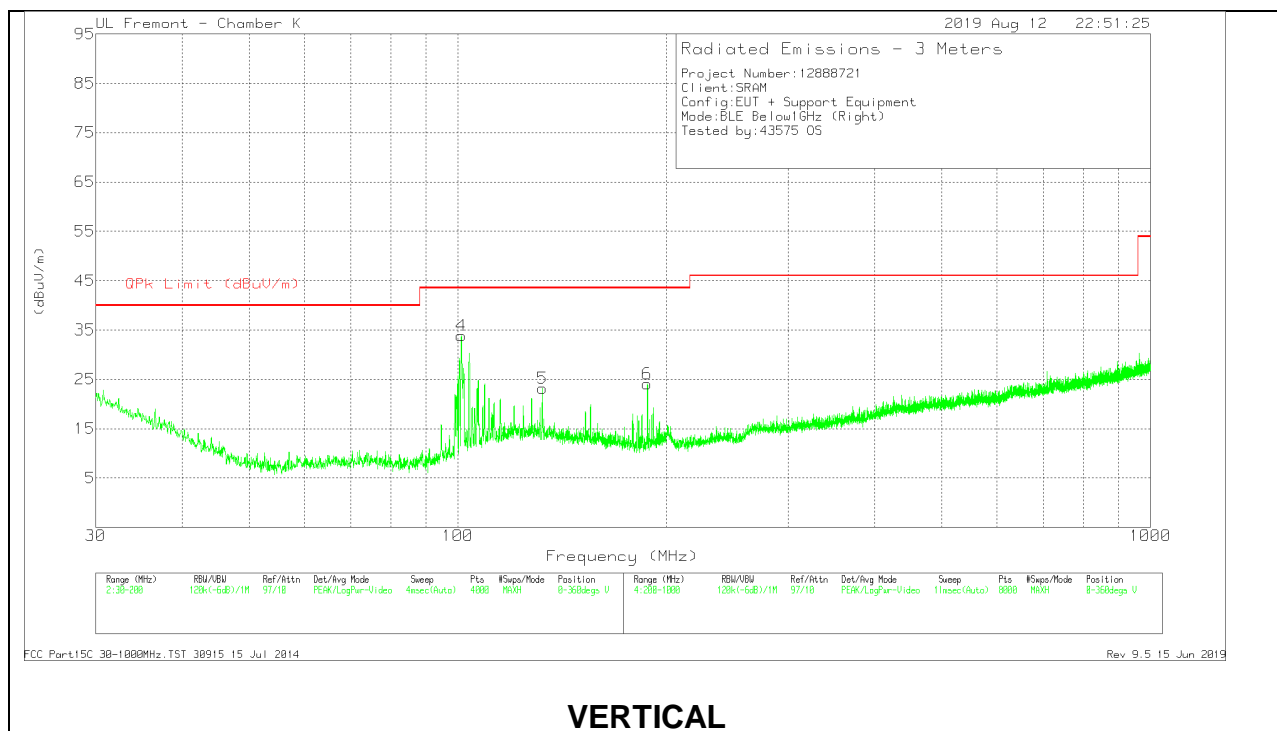

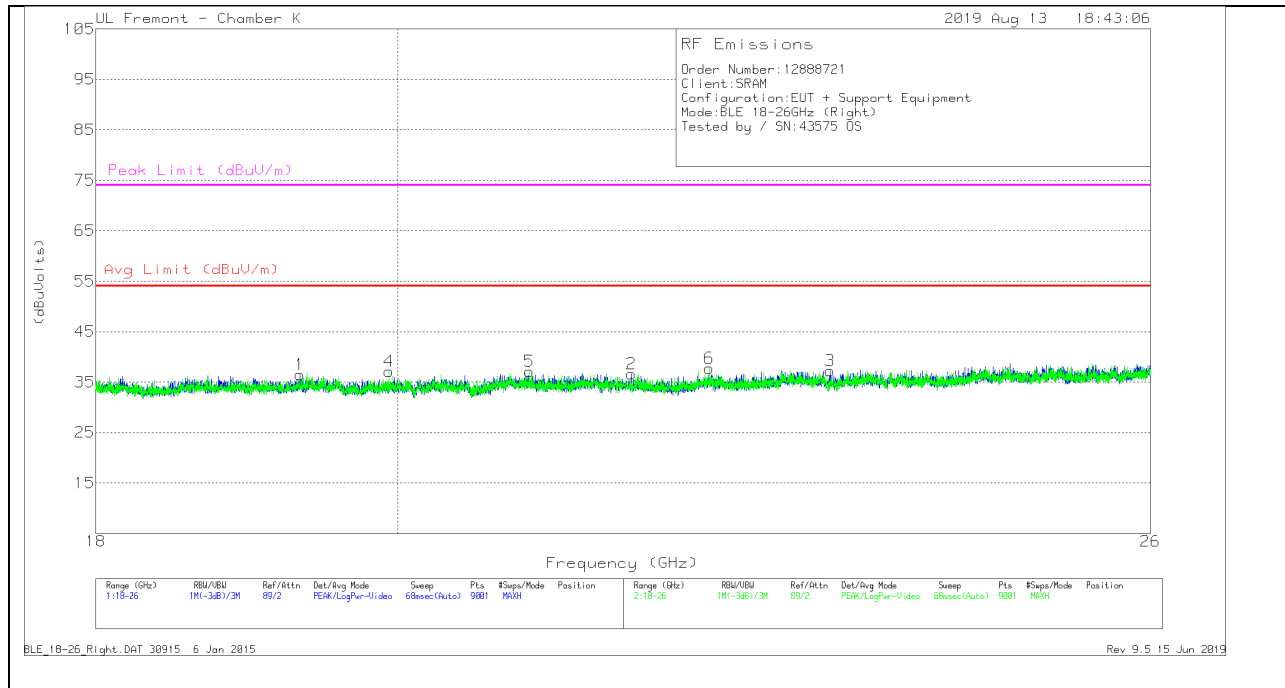
