## **RF EXPOSURE**

The subject device is a Low Power Device Transmitter and is subject to FCC radiation limits in 15.231(b) and IC limits in RSS-210, Sec. 6.1. At the highest frequency of operation (418 MHz), the maximum allowed field at 3 meters, for both FCC and IC, is  $80.3 \ dB\mu V/m$ . This corresponds to an EIPR of -14.9 dBm or 0.0323 mW.

Assuming a model of a point source radiator, the power density would be 0.01 mW/cm2 at 0.5 cm distance, a distance that is well inside the plastic case of the device.

## **FCC**

This estimate definitely meets the FCC guideline of 1 mW/cm2.

## IC

Since the radiated power is less than 200 mW, the device is exempt from RF Exposure regulations (RSS-102, 4.2).
