After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) During your last set of uploads, confidentiality was checked for tuning procedure, amplifier schematic, external and internal photographs. Earlier uploads marked the block diagram, part list (BOM), and schematics as confidential. The letter requesting confidentiality does not match all the files checked. However, the FCC will only grant confidentiality on the schematics (TX and amplifier sections), block diagrams (which includes a short theory of operation) & parts list. The new operational description provided does not contain any confidential information and was not checked as confidential. Please submit a new letter requesting confidentiality for only the schematics, block diagrams, and parts list. All other documentation will be considered public.
- 2) One of the internal photographs provided that appears to mount behind the antenna seems to contain a shield. Please provide photographs of this board with the shield removed.
- 3) The users manuals statements will still need to contain the following statements.  
CAUTION STATEMENT:  
To comply with FCC RF exposure compliance requirements, a separation distance of 2.5 cm must be maintained between the antenna of this device and all persons.
