In response to your e-mail dated October 13, 1999, Hyundai Electronics Industries Co., Ltd. hereby confirms that the ear-microphone jack indicated in the instruction manual is intended for hands-free operation, which enables the phone to be used in a body-worn configuration. Based on the additional SAR measurements performed at PCTEST Lab for body-worn configuration (see attached), Hyundai Electronics Industries Co., Ltd. confirms that we will implement the following warning statement in the instruction manual:

For body-worn operation, the antenna should be kept at least one half inch from the body when transmitting.
