I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that the confidentiality request includes the PWB artwork, Parts list and Tune up procedures. Please note that these specific items are not required exhibits for a part 15 device. However, if they are listed on the confidentiality request, then they must be uploaded to the FCC at the time of certification. Please either remove these specific items from the confidentiality request, or please provide all of these exhibits.
2. Please note that the manual does not appear to provide the required statement in accordance with 15.21 whereby the user is cautioned that unauthorized changes or modifications not approved by the party responsible may void the users authority to operate the equipment. The existing modification statement only states that the grantee has to approve modifications. Please note that this is not in accord with the FCC rules as it does not inform the user that unauthorized modification may void the users authority to operate the equipment. Please provide a manual which provides this caution.
3. Please provide a manual with the required 15.105 information to user statement.
