I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that page 38 of the report states : Part 15.207 – Radio Frequency Devices - Subpart C – Unintentional Radiators.” Please note that Part 15.207 is for intentional radiators and not unintentional radiators. Please explain.
2. Please note that while the FCC may accept CISPR22 conducted data for unintentional radiators, it does not accept EN55022 data for unintentional radiators nor does it accept CISPR22 or EN55022 for intentional radiators. Conducted emissions for intentional radiators must be done in accordance with Part 15.207 and not EN55022 nor CISPR22. This means that in the frequency range between 150kHz to 500kHz the limit is 66 to 56dBuV decreasing linearly with log of frequency. While the limits may be similar, reference to test standards and limits must be correct for the purpose of certification. Please explain why reference to EN55022 conducted test method is made.
