



To Set Up

Parent's Unit

For portable use, install the batteries:

- 1. Using a screwdriver, turn the screw on the battery compartment cover to loosen, and remove the cover.
- 2. Insert four AAA 1.5v batteries (alkaline recommended). Position them so the + and - contacts are aligned with the corresponding contacts in the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the battery compartment cover and tighten the screw.



!\ WARNING:

- Keep batteries away from children. Parents are urged to exercise care in the storage, use, and disposal of all batteries.
- DO NOT attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- DO NOT dispose of batteries in fire; they may explode.
- If using rechargeable batteries, remove from product before recharging. Recharging should be done only under adult supervision.

To avoid battery leakage:

- Be sure to position + and symbols as indicated in battery compartment.
- Never mix old and new batteries, rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries, or standard (carbon zinc) and alkaline batteries.

Nursery Unit


- 1. Position the Nursery Unit upright on its wide, round base, and within approximately 6 feet of your child, yet out of the child's reach.
 - To prevent heat build-up, place on an open surface away from heat sources; do not place in an enclosed space.



WARNING:

Do not place Nursery Unit in crib or attach to crib.

2. Insert the AC adapter plug into the jack on the bottom of the unit, then plug the adapter into an electrical outlet.



Using belt clip: Rotate the clip with the opening downward and slide onto your bolt or waistband

Using stand: Rotate belt clip/stand with opening upward, bull out base and place unit on any flat surface

Changing channels: Always keep both units set to the same channel (A or B). If you experience interference or static with one channel, switch to the other.

To Clean Both Units

Wipe exterior surfaces with a clean, dry cloth



Troubleshooting

Red power indicator lights do not light up.	Units not turned on.	Turn units on,
	Batteries in Parent's Unit are dead.	Replace batteries,
	Adapters not properly attached to units.	Attach adapters firmly to AC jacks on units.
	Adapters not plugged in to wall outlets.	Plug in adapters.
	Adapter(s) plugged in to outlet that's turned off.	If outlet is controlled by a wall switch, be sure switch is turned on.
Hissing or Loud Rushing Sound	Parent's Unit is turned on. but Nursery Unit is off.	Leave Nursory Unit plugged in and turne on at all times (or, if you turn it off, turn off Parent's Unit also.) Be sure Nursery Unit is set to same channel as Parent's Unit.
Static or Interference	Units set to different channels.	Set both units to the same channel.
(You may hear sounds from outside your home, and/or you may hear rushing background noises, even though you can still heard your child.)	Appliances (fan, hair dryer or mixer, for example) causing interference.	Try turning off any nearby appliances or switching channels.

To Use Nightlight/Lullaby Player

- 1. Slide the on/off/timer switch to the on position.
- 2. Gently press the top of Pooh's head once to turn the soft nightlight and lullaby on.
- Use the volume control dial to turn the lullaby on and off and to adjust loudness.

Press Pooh's head again to turn them off.

Note: The lullaby player will not work unless the soft nightlight is turned also on.

Timer

Slide the on/off/timer switch to the timer position. Soft nightlight (and Lullaby Player, if it is on) will turn off automatically after five minutes.

Monitor

Note: When Nursery Unit is plugged in is it automatically turned on, and will stay on, whether Soft Nightlight and Lullaby Player are turned on or off, and even if the timer is being used.

- 1. Slide the on/off/timer switch on the Nursery Unit to the on position.
- 2. Slide the channel switch on the Nursery Unit to either A or B.
- Slide the channel selector switch on the Parent's Unit to the same channel as the Nursery Unit (A or B). For the Monitor to work properly, both units must be set to the same channel.
- 4. Slide the receiving options switch on the Parent's Unit to your preferred setting:

LIGHT AND SOUND - to hear your baby and to turn on moving light display.

MUTE - to turn on moving light display only; you will not be able to hear your baby.

SOUND ONLY - to hear your baby; light display will be turned off. This setting is recommended for portable use, as it will conserve battery power.

- 5. Turn the volume dial on the Parent's Unit clockwise to the desired loudness level.
- 6. Keep the Parent's Unit with you. Depending on the setting you choose, you will be able hear the sounds your child is making and/or see the loudness level of the sounds in your child's room.

Positioning units: For best reception be certain both units are upright.

Power Indicator: This light will be on when both units are turned on and set to transmit your baby's sounds. The light will not be on when you set the Parent's Unit to MUTE.

Moving Lights: The semi-circle of lights around the top of the Parents Unit will light up when your baby makes a noise. The louder your baby's sounds, the more lights will turn on and move from left to right.

Range: The range of the Monitor will vary with the surroundings, You may want to test its workable range by walking through your house and yard and listening for the volume and clarity of the sounds being transmitted.

One (1) Year Limited Warranty
