Hello,

Yesterday, I submitted a Class II modification of presently authorized equipment application under DYDWT3200 (Form 731 confirmation number EA98616). I had hoped to make the test report confidential and, for that reason, submitted the application with the confidentiality option selected. The fees were \$45 and \$135 for a total of \$180.

Although I checked the "Instructions for Submitting FCC Form 731 Attachments" and Sec. 0.457 and 0.459 prior to selecting the confidentiality feature, I didn't see anything that listed which documents were exempt from confidentiality. I was unaware of this exemption until I reached the "Add Attachments" page and checked the "Instructions for Submitting FCC Form 731 Attachments." Since test reports won't be held confidential, there isn't any reason for us to use the confidentiality clause for this application, and we have submitted all of our attachments without any confidentiality requests.

How do we adjust the amount of fees due to remove the \$135 confidentiality fee?

It would be helpful to have access at the application level to the "Additional Information" regarding confidentiality that is contained in the attachments instructions.

Thank you very much for your assistance. I'll wait to submit payment until I hear from you.
