4.2 EUT OPERATION CONDITION

1. Turn on the power of all equipments.
2. PC runs a test program to enable all functions.
3. PC sends "H" messages to monitor and monitor displays "H" patterns on screen.
4. PC sends "H" messages to modem.
5. PC sends "H" messages to printer, and the printer prints them on paper.
6. PC sends audio message to external speaker.
7. Repeat steps 3-7.

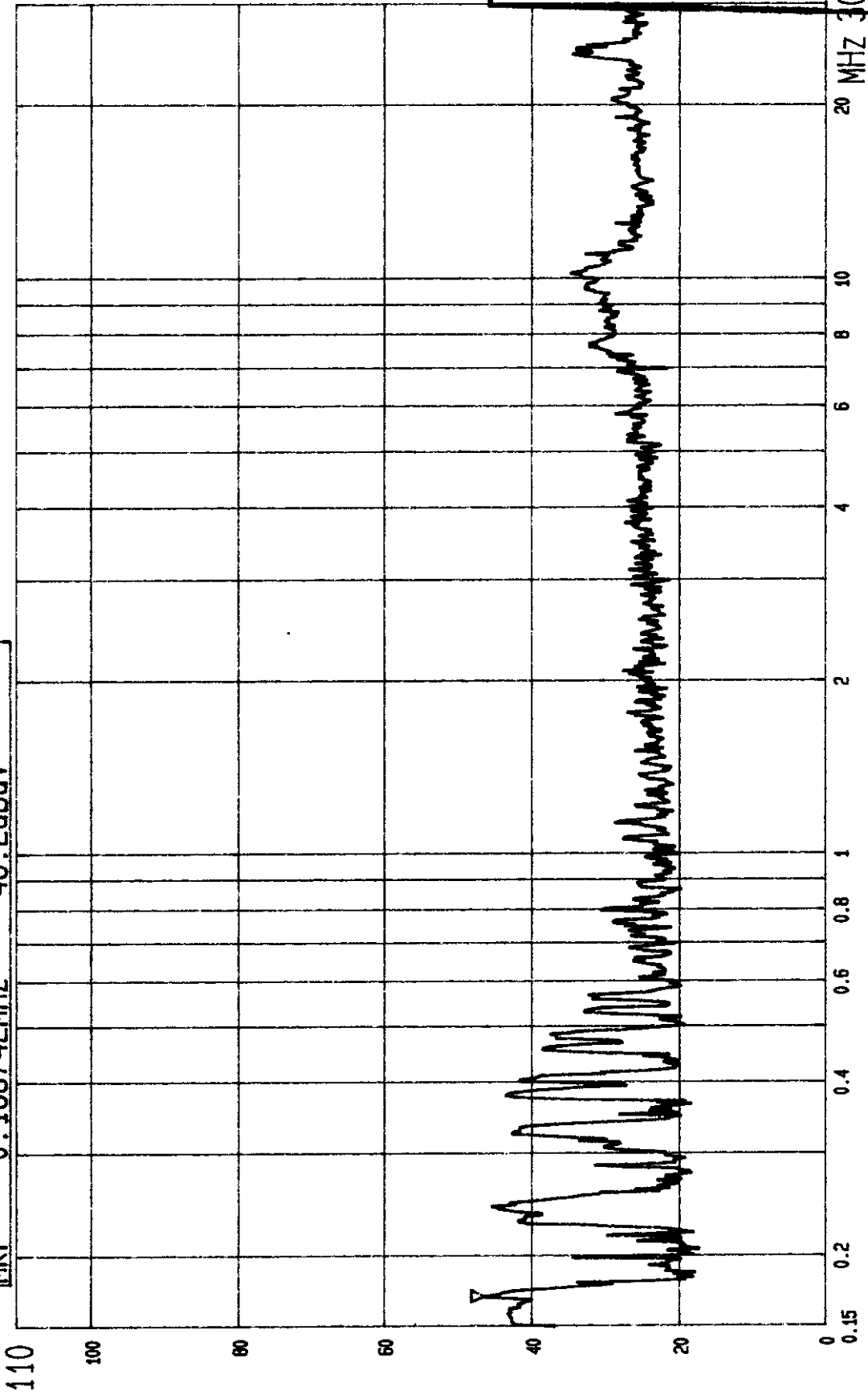
