Dear Eric Wong,

The initial review of the above referenced TCB application has been performed. The following items need to be addressed before the review can be continued:

1. The Confidentiality Request letter requests that the Schematics, Block Diagram and Operational Description exhibits be kept confidential. Please note that you have also submitted exhibits titled PCB.pdf which is the component placement and PCB trace diagrams and BOM.pdf which is the Chinese language Bill of materials. Although these exhibits are not required, they have been submitted and not currently covered by the Confidentiality Request letter. If you do not wish for these exhibits to become publicly available on the FCC 网站 web site, please either request for CCS to remove them from the application or revise the Confidentiality Request letter to specifically include these exhibits.

<Aven> : Please help to remove them from the application.

2. The Users Manual does not include the required statement from FCC 15.21 regarding the notice about modifications. Please submit an updated Users Manual to include this required information.

<Aven>: The attached is the update user manual.

3. The test report does not indicate which version of ANSI C63.4 has been used for testing. Please update the test report to indicate which year version of ANSI C63.4 has been used.

<Aven>: The attached is update report.

4. The Users Manual states that this device can use different channels. Please confirm if these different channels use the same 27.045 MHz center frequency or if they operate on different frequencies.

<Aven>: Confirm by the tested sample that these different channels use the same 27.045 MHz center frequency

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of the original e-mail date may result in application dismissal and forfeiture of the filing fee. Also, please note that partial responses increase processing time and should not be submitted. Any questions about the content of this correspondence should be directed to the e-mail address listed below the name of the sender.
