



Charging your earbuds

Earbuds must be charged before use.

- · Connect small plug of USB charging cable to USB port and
- connect the other end to a powered USB port. • Indicator will glow red while charging and turn glow blue once charged.
- Earbuds should provide about 4 hours of audio when fully charged.

BLUETOOTH

1. The FIRST TIME EARBUDS ARE POWERED ON they enter auto-pairing mode. The indicator on the dongle will flash blue and red and a voice prompt will announce "power on", then "pairing".
