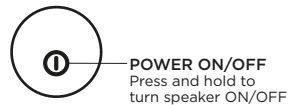

BOTTOM OF UNIT



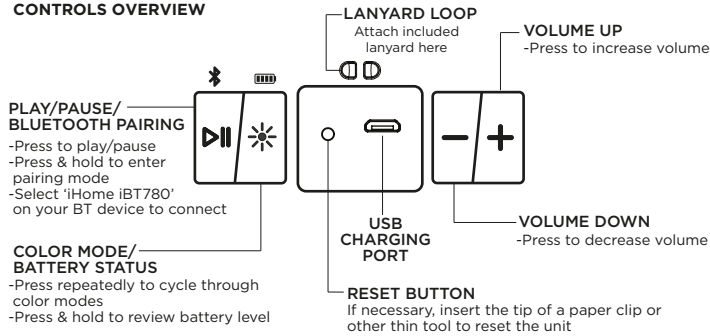
POWER ON/OFF

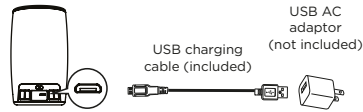
