Re: Waiver Order DA 07-3160 and Notice of FDA Approval on May 8, 2008 for COGNIS 100-D and TELIGEN 100 devices (ESCCRMN11906)

Federal Communications Commission:

The FCC waiver Order (DA 07-3160) released on July 11, 2007 specifies at paragraphs 8 and 15 that Boston Scientific shall, in connection with its application for equipment certification (FCC ID ESCCRMN11906), provide to the Commission the date of final FDA approval of Boston Scientific's COGNIS 100-D and TELIGEN 100 devices (to align the FCC waiver term with FDA approval).

Final FDA approval for the first devices in the COGNIS 100-D and TELIGEN 100 device series was received on May 8, 2008.<sup>1</sup> A redacted version of the FDA approval letter is attached.
