Re: EUG DR-135T Cellular Exclusion

To Whom It May Concern,

In accordance with F.C.C. Rules and Regulations, Part 15.121, Alinco model number EUGDJ-135T transceivers will have the following CPU installed in all U.S. version units that will display the "T" identifier at the end of the model number.

CPU parts number : manufacturer's code M38267M8L (IC1)

This CPU has been specially designed to exclude the U.S. cellular telephone band. This CPU can't be manipulated in any way, whether by software or hardware, to enhance or modify the band plan of the EUGDJ-135T to receive the U.S. cellular bands per F.C.C. Rules and Regulations (15.121).

Once the CPU is burned with this restricted protocol at the CPU manufacturer's factory, there is no way to change the data without destroying the CPU. In addition, as the diagram clearly shows, the circuit has been designed exclusively to work as a VHF 144 MHz amateur radio band transceiver, NOT as a wideband receiver with multiple frequencies receiving up to 800MHz range.
