Gentlemen:

Enclosed, find First International Computer Inc.'s application for equipment authorization, dated November 2, 1999. The subject device was originally granted on August 23, 1999 in compliance with Part 15, Subpart B of the FCC Rules.

The subject device was originally reported as a Multimedia Notebook Computer initially marketed with features such as: (1) one-of-six type Pentium II CPUs by Celeron types 266, -300, -333 or Dixon types 300, -333, -366 with 66 MHz external clock frequency; (2) one-of-four type LCDs with maximum resolution 1024x768, Non-Interlaced; (3) one-of-thirteen type hard disk drives and one-of-two type floppy disk drives; (4) one-of-two type CD-ROM Drives or one-of two type DVD ROM Drives; (5) LAN or Modem Card; (6) AC Adaptor by Delta, type ADP-50MB provided DC cable with one bonded ferrite core; and (7) various other features and options.

This Class II Change is to report: (1) five alternate Pentium CPUs by Celeron types 366, -400, -433, -466 or Dixon type 400 with 66 MHz external clock frequency; (2) two alternate LCDs with maximum resolution 1024x768, Non-Interlaced; (3) three alternate type hard disk drives; (4) two alternate type CD-ROM Drives; and (5) one alternate DVD ROM Drive.

This EUT was multimedia system tested with all six five CPUs and two LCDs in various system configurations with all available interface ports connected to suitable peripheral devices. Tests were performed in accordance with ANSI C63.4-1992 with radiated measurements performed up to 2 GHz to show compliance to FCC Part 15 Class B limits.
