- 1) Please comment on your response to item 4). You states 2402 – 2462. Is this correct? Typically this is 2412 – 2462.
- 2) The following information is confusing and should be reworded or removed from the users manual. Please correct.

15.247 (b)(4), the EUT meets the requirement that it be operated in a manner that ensures the public is not exposed to radio frequency energy levels in excess of the Commission's guidelines (1.1307, 1.1310, 2.1091 and 2.1093)

- 3) The users manual page 30 and 31 should remove item 4 from the diagram and list. The manufacturer should not provide any information to the user as to where to find the TX device.
