Overview: In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act, this document has been created to justify and define the RF exposure environmental conditions of the COM 2000.

Information: The COM 2000 is considered to be a fixed transmitter containing a less-than-10-watt transmitter operating between 117.975 and 137.000 MHz. This device is designed to be permanently installed in an aircraft and connected to an external antenna no less than 20 centimeters from the user or any passengers.

The COM 2000 is certified under rule part 87, and is therefore categorically excluded from all environmental testing underneath 2.1091 or 2.1093.
