Dear Ms. Green, Mr. Dayhoff and Mr. Coperich:

We are writing in response to your separate requests for further information concerning the application to transfer the FCC Identification number of device F9C-CMM92STD.¹ On behalf of Schlumberger Resource Management Services, Inc. ("Schlumberger"), in August and September, 2000, we submitted applications to change all of the FCC Identification numbers held by CellNet Data Systems, Inc. ("CellNet"), grantee code H6N, to Schlumberger's grantee code, F9C. The purpose of these applications was to notify the Commission that Schlumberger purchased the assets of CellNet, including the equipment authorizations. The submissions consisted of a separate Form 731 for each of the devices and a single Form 159, which included payment for a single fee intended to cover all of the FCC Identification number transfers.

On September 28, 2000, we received e-mail correspondence from Ms. Elliott requesting further information regarding H6N-CCM92STD. Ms. Elliott requested that we supply

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information concerning the former FCC ID numbers for the device. On October 6, 2000, we received e-mail correspondence from Mr. Coperich inquiring why Schlumberger filed an application for H6N-CCM92STD when a new application had been filed under F9C-CMM92STD. On October 18, 2000 we received e-mail correspondence from Mr. Dayhoff requesting that Schlumberger submit a photograph of the general appearance of the device and a copy of the RF Exposure Evaluation completed for the device. On November 13, 2000, we received further e-mail correspondence from Ms. Elliott requesting that the applicant for H6N-CCM92STD immediately pay the filing fee.²

Schlumberger has determined to utilize the verification procedures for all newly manufactured equipment, as provide for in section 101.139(b).³ For equipment including H6N-CCM92STD that is currently authorized under the former notification process, Schlumberger has determined not to change the FCC Identifier. Accordingly, we withdraw the application, Form 731 Confirmation Number EA98808, filed on September 20, 2000, for this device, and thus your inquiries related to this application are now moot.

In Mr. Dayhoff's e-mail correspondence of October 18, 2000, he requested the submission of a copy of the RF evaluation pursuant to section 2.1091. As an initial matter, the device, a Part 101 Licensed Non-Broadcast Station Transmitter, is not a "mobile device" as contemplated under section 2.1091(b). Furthermore, this device is categorically excluded from the requirement to perform a routine environmental evaluation for RF emissions pursuant to section 1.1307(b)(1) Table 1.

We are submitting a copy of this letter with its accompanying attachments to each of the individuals referenced above. We are also submitting this letter and accompanying attachments electronically, within 60 days of the earliest e-mail inquiry we received.
