Dear Mr. Dayhoff:

We are writing in response to your requests for further information concerning the application to transfer the FCC Identification number of device F9C-CMM95STD. On behalf of Schlumberger Resource Management Services, Inc. ("Schlumberger"), in August and September, 2000, we submitted applications to change all of the FCC Identification numbers held by CellNet Data Systems, Inc. ("CellNet"), grantee code H6N, to Schlumberger's grantee code, F9C. The purpose of these applications was to notify the Commission that Schlumberger purchased the assets of CellNet, including the equipment authorizations. The submissions consisted of a separate Form 731 for each of the devices and a single Form 159, which included payment for a single fee intended to cover all of the FCC Identification number transfers.

On October 18, 2000, we received e-mail correspondence from you requesting that Applicant submit a photograph of the general appearance of the device and a copy of the RF Exposure Evaluation pursuant to section 2.1091 of the Commission's rules.<sup>1</sup>

Schlumberger has determined to utilize the verification procedures for newly manufactured equipment, as provided for in section 101.139(b).<sup>2</sup> For equipment including H6N-CRR95STD that is currently authorized under the former notification process, Schlumberger has determined not to change the FCC Identifier. Accordingly, we withdraw the application, Form 731 Confirmation Number EA98809, filed on September 20, 2000, for this device, and thus your inquiries related to this application are now moot.

In your e-mail correspondence of October 18, 2000, you requested the submission of a copy of the RF evaluation pursuant to section 2.1091. As an initial matter, the device, a Part 101 Licensed Non-Broadcast Station Transmitter, is not a "mobile device" as contemplated under section 2.1091(b). Furthermore, this device is categorically excluded from the requirement to perform a routine environmental evaluation for RF emissions pursuant to section 1.1307(b)(1) Table 1.

We are also submitting this letter electronically within 60 days of your e-mail inquiry. Should you have any questions regarding this matter, please contact Zachary Zehner at (202) 383-3424 to expedite resolving any outstanding issues.
