The Digicall Spectrum Lab was originally designed using an RF module (Part 15 unlicensed 902-928 MHz band) manufactured by Radiotronics located in Oklahoma, USA. The module is used in the Digicall Spectrum console (FCC ID: FBRECM9XX) and student unit (FCC ID: FBRDS6MA). Fleetwood has engineered an equivalent module to be manufactured by Fleetwood Group Inc. and has utilized Elite Electronics Engineering Inc. to perform the appropriate tests to confirm that it complies with FCC regulations Part 15 as did the original module. We are therefore requesting that usage of this module be accepted as a Class II permissive change. Supplemental documentation on the module including schematic, block diagram, and operational description is included.
