I have a few comments on this Application. Please do not put confidential information in your responses to these questions as the response letter will not be held confidential by the FCC. Depending on your answers there may be more questions.

1 The Form 731 states the power to be 0.095 Watts and the test report confirms that the power is 19.77 dBm which is 0.095 watts. The MPE report however states that the power is 0.0095 watts and therefore is below the 60/2475MHz threshold and does not need MPE or SAR. As this is a handheld device and would be considered portable and the power level is indeed above the threshold of 60/freq then the EUT will have to be tested for SAR as a portable device with a power of 0.095 watts. Please have the EUT tested for SAR and submit a SAR report with this application showing compliance.

Response: Please refer to the revised confidential operational description submitted with this response; SAR is not required.

2 Please revise test setup photos to one that are clear and not out of focus.

Response: Please refer to the revised test setup photo exhibit submitted with this response.

3 Internal photos need to show what is under the battery and where the TX is located. Please revise internal photos.

Response: There are no components under the battery. The TX is at the top of the PCB, above the horizontal break in the ground plane (about the top 20% of the PCB). A revised internal photograph exhibit that includes this explanation has been submitted with this response.
