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1. GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 Product Description

The Datacomp Electronics Co., Ltd., Model: 5833 (referred to as the EUT in this report) is ~ 2.4 GHz transmitter, the major technical descriptions of EUT is described as following:

A). Operation Frequency: 2402 – 2480MHz, 79 channels, 1MHz step.

B). Modulation Type: DSSS, GFSK

C). Power Supply: 3 Vdc from 2*A battery.

D). Antenna Designation: Non-User Replaceable (Fixed)

1.2 Related Submittal(s) / Grant (s)

This submittal(s) (test report) is intended for FCC ID: <u>FBX-5833-0608-01</u> filing to comply with Section 15.249 of the FCC Part 15, Subpart C Rules. The composite system (digital device) is compliance with Subpart B is authorized under a verification procedure.

1.3 Test Methodology

Both conducted and radiated testing were performed according to the procedures in ANSI C63.4 (2003). Radiated testing was performed at an antenna to EUT distance 3 meters.

1.4 Test Facility

The open area test site and conducted measurement facility used to collect the radiated data is located on the address of SGS Taiwan Ltd. No. 134, Wu Kung Rd., Wuku Industrial Zone, Taipei Country, Taiwan. The Open Area Test Sites and the Line Conducted labs are constructed and calibrated to meet the FCC requirements in documents ANSI C63.4: 2003 and CISPR 22/EN 55022 requirements. Site No. 1(3 &10 meters) Registration Number: 94644, Both OATS and Anechoic chamber (3 meters) was accredited by TAF (0513).

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2. System Test Configuration

2.1 EUT Configuration

The EUT configuration for testing is installed on RF field strength measurement to meet the Commissions requirement and operating in a manner which intends to maximize its emission characteristics in a continuous normal application.

2.2 EUT Exercise

The Transmitter was operated in the engineering operating mode. the Tx frequency was fixed which was for the purpose of the measurements.

2.3 Test Procedure

2.3.1Conducted Emissions

The EUT is a placed on as turn table which is 0.8 m above ground plane. According to the requirements in Section 7 and 13 of ANSI C63.4-2003. Conducted emissions from the EUT measured in the frequency range between 0.15 MHz and 30MHz using CISPR Quasi-Peak and Average detector mode.

2.3.2Radiated Emissions

The EUT is a placed on as turn table which is 0.8 m above ground plane. The turn table shall rotate 360 degrees to determine the position of maximum emission level. EUT is set 3m away from the receiving antenna which varied from 1m to 4m to find out the highest emission. And also, each emission was to be maximized by changing the polarization of receiving antenna both horizontal and vertical. In order to find out the max. emission, the relative positions of this hand-held transmitter(EUT) was rotated through three orthogonal axes according to the requirements in Section 8 and 13 of ANSI C63.4-2003.

Fig. 2-1 Configuration of TX



Channel low (2402MHz) · mid (2441MHz) and high (2480MHz) with highest data rate are chosen for full testing.



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
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4. Conducted Emissions Test

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

5.1 Measurement Procedure


- 1. The EUT was placed on a turntable that is 0.8m above ground plane.

5.4 Field Strength Calculation

The field strength is calculated by adding the Antenna Factor and Cable Factor and subtracting the Amplifier Gain and Duty Cycle Correction Factor(if any) from the measured reading. The basic equation with a sample calculation is as follows:

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6. 26 dB Band Width Measurement

6.1 Measurement Procedure

- 1. The EUT was placed on a turn table which is 0.8m above ground plane.
- 2. Set ETU normal operating mode.
- 3. Set SPA Center Frequency = fundamental frequency, RBW, VBW = 100KHz, Span = 3MHz.
- 4. Set SPA Max hold. Mark peak, -26dB.


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26 dB Band Width test Plot (Ch Low)
