The Federal Aviation Administration, Spectrum Engineering Services Group has received the Cobham Avionics, letter dated Feb 22, 2013 regarding a request for Federal Communications Commission (FCC) certification of the RT-5000P AM Voice Transceiver, with FCC ID: FRWRT-5000P. This transceiver would operate, in the aviation protected 118 to 137 MHz communications band, for which the approved channel spacing is 25 kHz in the United States National Air Space.
