After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) Please justify the use of the DoC labeling information (FCC Logo). This labeling is reserved for particular approvals that do not appear to apply to this application (PC Peripheral, Stand alone RX, etc.). It appears that this information should not be on the label. If justification can not be made for the FCC logo, please provide revised labeling.
- 2) It appears that several different labels were provided. Please revise the exhibit to only include the label for this device.
- 3) The operational description provided mentions manual operation of a button. This device does not appear to contain a button but appears to be automatically activated. Please explain how this device is activated.
- 4) <u>Test data must be provided</u> that shows compliance to 15.231(a)(1) to show that this device ceases operation within 5 seconds (i.e., plot should show 15-20 seconds to adequately show transmission period and TX shut off.
- 5) Please explain compliance to 15.231(a)(3).
- 6) Please explain if the data provided on pages 13, 15, 17 is peak or average data.
- 7) FYI......If it is determined that a DoC was not necessary, then they DoC compliance statement is not required to be submitted.
