

Connecting the InnoTV[™] Console to a TV

- 1. Turn off your television set.
- Plug one end (near the ferrite core) of the HDMI cable into the HDMI Out port located on the back of the console, and then connect the other end to the HDMI port on the television.
- 3. Insert the Power Adaptor plug into the InnoTV[™], and then plug the Power Adaptor into a power outlet.
- 4. Turn on your television set and select the proper HDMI input.



Turning on the Console

Turn on the TV, and then set the TV input to HDMI.

Press the UP (Power) button on the InnoTV™ console to turn it on. A green light will be shown around the button.




Setting up the Controller

Insert two AA batteries into the back of the controller.



Attach the wrist strap to the controller.



Press the (Ower) button on the InnoTV™ controller to turn the controller on. A green light will come on.

Make sure the player selector on the bottom of the controller is on player 1.

Setting up the InnoTV[™]

Follow these steps to set up your InnoTV™:

- 1. Set up an Internet connection.
- Your InnoTV[™] console may require a firmware update before use. If this is the case, follow the instructions on-screen to download and install the firmware update.
- 3. Once installation is completed the console will restart, and you will be prompted to register your InnoTV[™]. Complete the necessary steps to register your console.
- 4. Don't forget to set a Parental Controls passcode when you've finished to prevent your child from accessing the console settings.



Inserting/Removing Cartridges

Insert a cartridge into the cartridge slot on the top of the console. The cartridge should lock into place.

Press the (Eject) button to remove the cartridge.
