Description of EUT Operation:

The Equipment Under Test (EUT) is a NEW BRIGHT INDUSTRIAL CO., LTD of Radio Control toy. The transmitter is 2 sticks transmitter and operating at 27.145MHz. The EUT continues to transmit sticks are being pushed or pulled, Modulation by IC, and type is pulse modulation.

The transmitter has different control:

- 1. Left stick forward and backward control
- 2. Right stick leftward and rightward control

Antenna Requirement

The EUT is use of a permanently antenna. The antenna consists of 36cm long wire antenna. It is soldered on the PCB. The antenna is not replaceable or user serviceable. There are no deviations or exceptions to the specifications.


Radiated emissions measurements are investigated and taken pursuant to the procedures of ANSI C63.4 - 2009.

The equipment under test (EUT) was placed on a non-conductive turntable with dimensions of 1.5m x 1m and 0.8m high above the ground. 3m from the EUT, a broadband antenna mounting on the mast received the signal strength. During the test, each emission was maximized by: having the EUT continuously working, investigated all operating modes, rotated about all 3 axis (X, Y & Z) and considered typical configuration to obtain worst position, manipulating interconnecting cables, For battery operated equipment, the equipment tests shall be perform using new battery. The turntable was rotated to maximize the emission level. The antenna was then moving along the mast from 1m up to 4m until no more higher value was found. Both horizontal and vertical polarization of the antenna were placed and investigated.

For below 30MHz, a loop antenna with its vertical plane is place 3m from the EUT and rotated about its vertical axis for maximum response at each azimuth about the EUT. And the centre of the loop shall be 1m above the ground.

Test Method:

The bandwidth is measured at an amplitude level reduced from the reference level by a specified ratio. The reference level is the level of the highest amplitude signal observed from the transmitter at the fundamental frequency. Once the reference level is established, the equipment is conditioned with typical modulating signal to produce the worst-case (i.e. the widest) bandwidth.



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Duty Cycle Correction During 100msec:

Each function key sends a different series of characters, but each packet period (70.2 msec) never exceeds a series of 1 long (0.6msec), 3 medium (0.3msec) and 8 short (0.1msec) pulses. Assuming any combination of short and long pulses maybe obtained due to encoding the worst case transmit duty cycle would be considered (0.6+3x0.3+8x0.1msec) per 70.2msec = 3.3% duty cycle. Figure A through C shows the characteristics of the pulse train for one of these functions.


Remarks: -

Duty Cycle Correction = 20Log(0.033) = -29.6dBTherefore -20 dB is taken as precedence.



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


