The following is in response to comments made on the above referenced Application.

Q: It is not certain if the labeling should be placed as indicated.

TRW wants to place the labels as indicated primarily for identification, marketing, and inventory reasons. Since the RX is entirely contained in the control module, its label will be on main module. For the LF transmitter, the circuitry is split between the control module and the "initiator" module. Here, TRW requests that the label be placed on the "initiator" module because, in the users/manufacturers view, the initiator is this module and the transmitting coil is contained therein.

Essentially, the labels are placed as such to avoid confusion and provide a means of identifying the RX and LF TX separately to the customer. Both modules will be sold together as part of the same model, 39360-S3V-A0.
