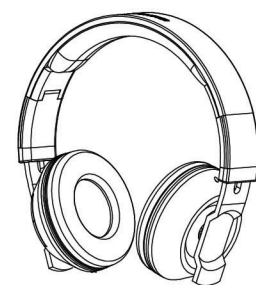

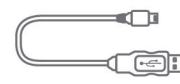

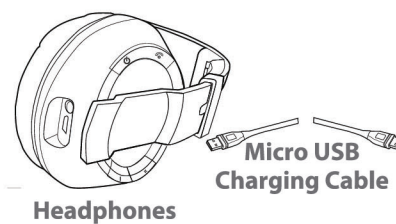
3.5mm

Charging Cable

Charging the Bluetooth Headphones

1. Connect the small end of the Micro USB cable to the charging port on the headphones.
2. Connect the large end of the Micro USB cable to your computer's USB port or an AC adapter (not included).
3. The LED indicator light turns RED when charging.
4. When fully charged, the LED indicator light turns OFF.
5. A voice prompt will be heard indicating that the headphones require charging.



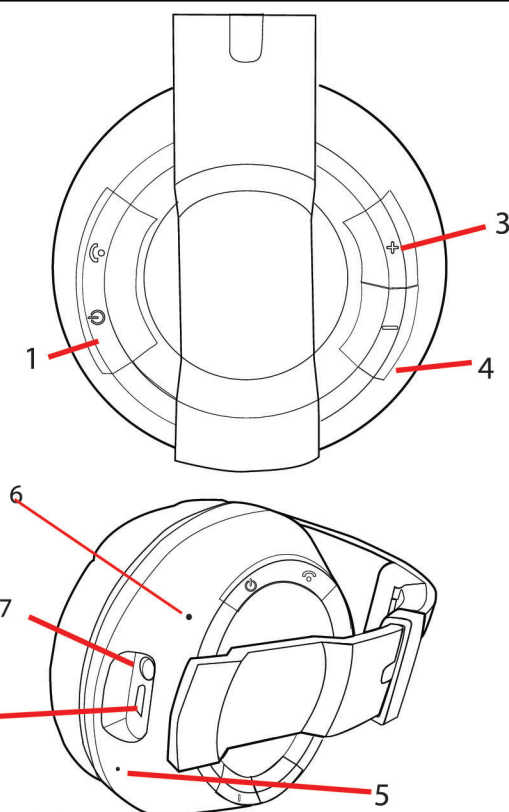

i Make sure you charge your headphones for at least 2 hours before using them for the first time.

Location of Controls



1. [Power] button:
 - Press and hold for 3 seconds to power ON
 - Press and hold for 3 seconds to power OFF
 - Quick press to answer/end call
 - Quick press to play / pause music
2. Micro USB charging port
3. [+] button:
 - quick press = next track
 - long press = increase volume
4. [-] button:
 - quick press = previous track
 - long press = decrease volume
5. Microphone
6. LED indicator light
7. Aux IN jack

Using your Bluetooth Headphones

Powering ON/OFF

- To turn ON, long press the [Power] button for 3 seconds.

- To turn OFF, long press the [Power] button for 3 seconds.

Adjusting the volume

- Long press the [+] button to increase the volume.
- Long press the [-] button to decrease the volume.

A tone will be heard when maximum volume is reached.

Play/pause

- Quick press the [Power] button to play music.
- Quick press the [Power] button to pause.

Skipping songs

- Quick press the [+] button to skip to the next track.
- Quick press the [-] button to skip to the previous track.

i NOTE: You can also adjust the volume from your mobile phone's volume control.

Answering / Ending Phone Calls

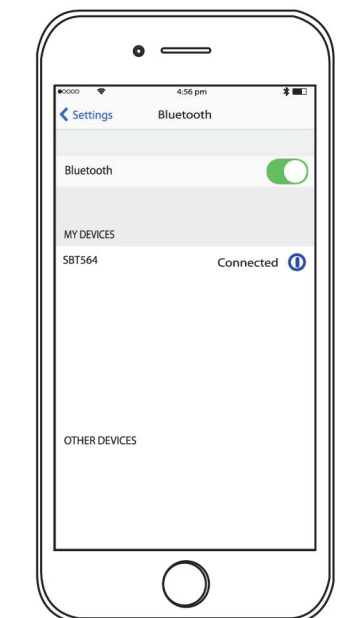
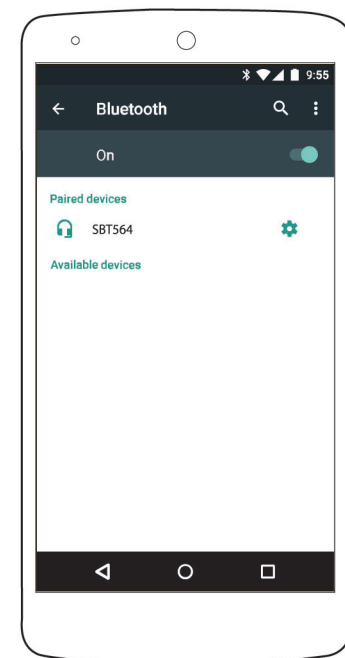
Answering/ending a call

- To answer a call, quick press the [Power] button.
- To end a call, quick press the [Power] button again.

i The music will pause automatically while a call is dialed out/incoming, and resume when the conversation has ended.

Pairing the headphones with a Bluetooth enabled device

1. Long press the [Power] button for 3 seconds to turn ON the Bluetooth headphones and enter pairing mode.
2. A tone will be heard. The BLUE indicator light will flash quickly.
3. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.



4. When the Bluetooth enabled device finds the headphones, select "SBT564" from the list of found devices.
5. After a successful registration, a tone will sound and the LED indicator light will slowly flash BLUE.

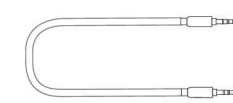
NOTE: Keep your Bluetooth headphones and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.

i The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth enabled devices in the market today, and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth enabled device's interface and interaction with the headphones may slightly differ from the illustrations above.

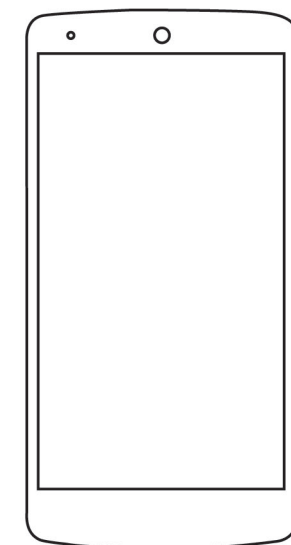
Using as wired headphones

1. Turn the headphones ON.
2. Connect one end of the included 3.5mm jack into the Aux jack on the headphones and the other end to an external device's headphone jack (smartphone, tablet, or MP3 player).
3. Open a media player on your device and press play to start playing your music.
4. Use the controls on your connected device to control music playback and volume.

NOTE: Only the volume and pause/play buttons on the headphones will be operational when in aux-in mode.

i Connecting the audio cable will override Bluetooth mode. When the cable is disconnected, the headphones will automatically reconnect to the last paired device.
