




Micro USB **Charging Cable**

LOCATION OF CONTROLS






Long press - Decrease volume

3. [►II]: Quick press - Play/pause 4. [►►/V+]: Quick press - Skip to next track


Long press - Increase volume 5. []: Quick press - Answer/end phone



HARGING THE HEADPHONE


To charge the headphones, connect the supplied micro USB cable to the USB charging port and the other end to your computer or USB charging device. The LED indicator light will turn RED when charging and turn off when finished.






ISING AS WIRED HEADPHONES

To use the headphones as a wired device, simply connect the supplied 3.5mm cable from the headphones AUX jack to your device's headphone or AUX jack (consult your device's manual for further assistance).



PAIRING THE HEADPHONES


- 1. Long press the [6] button to turn the headphones ON. A tone will be heard, indicating that the headphones are powered ON and in pairing mode. The LED indicator will quickly flash BLUE.
- 2. Set your Bluetooth-enabled device to search for Bluetooth
- 3. When the Bluetooth enabled device finds the headphones, select "PBT101" from the list of found devices.
- 4. After a successful pairing, a voice will be heard indicating that the device is paired and the LED indicator will slowly flash

PAIRING THE HEADPHONES (cont'd)

On an iPhone or Android

Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)







USING THE HEADPHONES

Powering ON/OFF

- Turn the headphones ON by long pressing the [也] button. A tone will be heard indicating that the earbuds are powered ON.
- Turn the headphones OFF by long pressing the [ひ] button. A tone will be heard indicating that the earbuds are powered OFF.

Answering Phone Calls

- To answer a phone call, quickpress the [?] button.
- To hang up, quick press the [?] button.

Redial Last Number Called

• Double press the [?] button to redial the last number called on your Bluetooth-paired phone.

PLAYING MUSIC

To enjoy music wirelessly on your Wireless Headphones, make sure that the earbuds are properly paired to your Bluetoothenabled device. If you are pairing the device for the first time, please consult the "Pairing the Earbuds" part of this user guide.

Playing/Pausing Music

- QUICK press the [►II] button to pause the music.
- QUICK press the [►||] button again to resume music playback.

- Quick press the [I44/V-] button to go to the previous song.
- Quick press the [▶►/ V+] button to go to the next song.

Adjusting the Volume

- Long press the [►
 Ito decrease the volume of music
- Long press the [►►/ V+] to increase the volume of music playback.
