Review of this application is complete, and we note the following:

ADMINISTRATIVE

- 1) The label contains Canadian compliance information for a digital device, but does not contain the corresponding FCC statement from 15.19(a) (3). Please comment.
- 2) No RF safety evaluation for MPE of this mobile device can be located. Please indicate where it can be found, or provide the exhibit.

TECHNICAL

- 1) The device meets the technical criteria for certification.

COMMENT

- 1) The User Manual contains Part 68 compliance information, but there does not appear to be a public network interface. The client may wish to delete this information. If there is a public network interface, Part 68/ACTA approval would be required, and the label would need to show a corresponding ACTA Product ID.
