Remote Start Operation:

TO REMOTE START THE VEHICLE:

When you want to start your vehicle,

- Press Ω on the two way or \bigstar button on the standard transmitter. Press Twice if the unit is programmed for safety start
- The parking light will activate to indicate the remote start received the signal.
- The engine will start in approximately 5 seconds.
- Once the engine is running, after couple seconds the parking lights will turn on and the climate controls will activate and adjust the vehicle's interior temperature to your preset setting.
- The vehicle will run for a programmable 5 to 30 minute cycle before shutting down.

NOTE: The Remote Start Unit will not start the vehicle if any one of the following conditions exists:

- 1. The hood is opened.
- 2. The brake pedal is pressed.
- 3. The optional remote start enable toggle is switched to the "OFF" position. (If installed)
- 4. The gear selector is in any gear other then "PARK" or "NEUTRAL".

SAFE START (Child safety mode)

Factory default is set to press the Ω_{or} button once on the transmitter to start the vehicle. Safety Start feature can be programmed to eliminate an accidental remote start:

1. The user presses the transmitter Ω_{or} buttons **twice** within 3 seconds to start the vehicle.

NOTE: Contact your installing dealer to de-activate this feature for one push start

OPERATE THE VEHICLE WHILE RUNNING FROM THE REMOTE START:

To operate the vehicle while the engine is running from the remote start,

- Insert the ignition key and turn it to "ON" (not the start) position.
- Press the brake pedal.

Note: If the brake pedal is pressed before the key is in the ON position, the engine will shut down.

TEMPORARY STOP FEATURE:

This feature allows the vehicle to remain running after the key has been removed from the ignition. This feature is useful for occasions when you wish to exit and lock the vehicle for short periods of time, but would like to leave the motor running and the climate control on.

- Before turning off the engine, press the Ω or \bigstar button on the transmitter and the LED indicator will flash 3 times to confirm enter.
- Turn the ignition key to OFF position. (The engine will stay running.)
- The engine will run until the pre-programmed time elapsed or shutdown input is received.

TO TURN OFF THE REMOTE START:

When the engine is running (by remote start), if you want to stop it,

Press Oor ★ button TWICE on the remote transmitter under the remote start mode.

Press the brake pedal

The vehicle will shut down and turn off the parking light to indicate the engine has stopped.

SHUT-DOWN INPUT FOR REMOTE STARTER:

If any of the following conditions exist while the system is operating, the engine will not start or will shut down immediately:

- 1. The hood is opened.
- 2. The brake pedal is pressed.
- 3. Engine is over-revved. {"Tachometer checking type" only}
- 4. The pre-programmed run time (5 /10 / 20 / 30 minutes) has elapsed.
- 5. Press O_{or} * button twice on the remote transmitter under remote start mode.
- 6. The vehicle refused to start running after {3} unsuccessful attempts.

BATTERY CHANGING:

Depending on the usage, the remote batteries should be changed at least once a year.

The 1-way remote, (E-7s) is powered by a pair of <u>3V, CR2016</u> batteries. These batteries are available at most locations batteries are sold and can be replaced by the user.

The Two-way (E1S Two Way) remote is powered by one **CR-2032** battery These batteries are available at most locations batteries are sold and can be replaced by the user. Typical battery life is 6 Months

PROGRAMMING TRANSMITTERS:

Note: This mode will only retain the last 4 remote transmitters programmed. If the transmitter memory is exceeded, the security system will start deleting transmitters from memory in chronological order.

- 1. Turn the Ignition 'switch 'OFF/ON' 4 TIMES and stay in ON position. "Within 15 seconds".
- 2. Push the Valet switch 4 times and hold it on the 4th push until a long chirp is heard then release the valet switch. You are now in the Transmitter programming mode.
- 3. Press and hold any button of the transmitter until the siren responds with a confirming chirp, indicating the signal has been stored into memory.
- 4. If you have additional transmitters (up to 4) that need to be programmed, repeat step 3 for each transmitter.

Exit: Turn Ignition to 'OFF' position, or leave it for 15 seconds. 3 long chirps & 3 parking light flashes will confirm exit.

ACTIVE LOCK:

- 1. Press \triangle button or \bigcirc + \triangle on the two way transmitter.
- 2. The horn, if installed will chirp once and parking lights will flash once indicating that the system is now active. The vehicle doors will lock upon activating when interfaced with the keyless entry system.

ACTIVE UNLOCK:

- 1. Press button on the transmitter.
- 2. The horn will chirp twice and parking light will flash twice to indicating that the keyless system is now unlocked. The vehicle doors will unlock.

DEACTIVATING WITHOUT A TRANSMITTER

The Override function may be used if the remote transmitter is lost or inoperative.

- 1. Enter the vehicle and turn the ignition switch to 'ON' position.
- 2. Within 10 seconds push and release the antenna mounted valet switch

VALET MODE:

The valet switch allows you to temporarily by-pass all system function, eliminating the need to hand your transmitter to parking attendants or garage mechanics. When the system is in valet mode, and remote start functions are bypassed, Enter Valet Mode:

- 1. Under Unlock condition, turn the ignition to "ON" position.
- 2. Press and hold the antenna mounted valet switch for 2 seconds until the LED turns on. The LED will remain on as long as the system is in 'valet mode'.

Exit Valet Mode:

- 1. Return to normal operation, turn ignition 'on'.
- 2. Press and hold valet switch for 2 seconds, The LED will turn off Indicating that the system has exited the valet mode.

IGNITION CONTROL DOOR LOCKS.

If the vehicle's door locks have been interfaced to the security system, the system will automatically lock the vehicle's doors when the ignition is turned "ON" and /or unlock the vehicle's doors when the ignition is turned "OFF".

TRUNK RELEASE (Additional Installation Required)

Press and hold the or button on the two way transmitter for 3 seconds to activate the trunk release or other electric devices.

PANIC FUNCTION: One way remote ONLY

The transmitter can be used as a remote panic switch to manually trigger the system in case of emergency.

- 1. Press and hold the button for 3 second. The unit will immediately sound.
- 2. During panic mode, the normal function of this transmitter button will be disabled. The transmitter $\mathbf{\Omega}$ and $\mathbf{\Omega}$ buttons can be used to lock and unlock the door (if the option is installed).
- 3. To stop the alarm, press and hold the transmitter button on the transmitter again for
