




The Two-Way remote transmitter is powered by one "AAA" Battery. When the power of the battery weakens

A constant icon shall be displayed on the **LCD** screen. When the old battery is replaced, there will be beep sounds to indicate the power is back up on the transmitter.







The One-way remote is powered by one CR2032 Battery. To replace battery use a coin or small flat blade screwdriver to carefully pry apart case

- i. Press the buttons the number of times corresponding to the Level you wish to select; the LCD will display LEVEL number (L1 L2 L3 L4)

Vehicle's Status Check / Alarm Report: Press ➡ button 1 time first then press and hold ➡ buttons for 1 second. The LCD remote transceiver will display current status of the vehicle. (Include trigger state of vehicle).

Button Beeper: Press button 2 times first then press and hold buttons for 1 second to enter Button Beeper Mode.

Under this mode press button to turn on the button beep B:OFF.

Button Lock Mode: Press button 3 times first then press and hold buttons for 1 second to enter Button Lock Mode.

Under this mode press button to select Button Lock On or Off. The remote control will beep/vibrate 2 times and icon will display when a button is pressed indicating it is locked.

Tone / Vibrating Mode: Press → button 2 times first then press → button to enter Tone / Vibrating Mode. Under this mode press → button to select Tone Mode (→ icon will display) or Vibrating Mode (→ icon will display) or both (→ and icon will display).

Second Vehicle Security Operation: Press button 3 times first then press button to enter Second Vehicle Security

Mode. Under this mode press button to select CAR 2 operation (icon and icon will disappear and icon will dis

Power Saver Mode: Press ➡ button 3 times first then press ★ button to enter Power Saver Mode, Under this mode press ★ button to enable power saver mode and ➡ icon will display or disable power save mode and ➡ icon will disappear While in Power Save Mode the LCD transmitter will not look for any incoming signals from the main unit until a button is pressed.

EXIT: Wait 10 seconds, or press the other buttons to leave the setting except the button
