


Note 1: To reset the MC55, press and hold the Power button for five (5) seconds.

Numeric Keypad





4 Scan/Action Button

5 End

6 Orange Key

7 Backlight

10 Start Menu

8 Blue Key

9 OK

Use this key to launch applications and select items (shown on the keypad in blue).

> Press the \infty key once to activate this mode followed by another key.

Use this key to access the secondary layer of characters and actions.

> Press the key once to lock the keypad in the Alpha state.

> Press the key a second time to return to the normal state.

Charging LED:

Flashing orange: Battery charging


Alpha-Numeric Keypad


Solid orange: Charging complete

GSM Status/Notification LED:

- Fast flashing green: GSM activity Solid green: Voice call in progress
- Flashing red: System notification

Insert the Battery





Charge the MC55 24hr*

to ensure that the internal battery is fully charged.

SIM Card Installation

- 1. Remove battery pack.
- 2. Slide SIM card holder to the left.
- 3. Lift card holder.
- 4. Insert SIM card into SIM holder.

The proper position of the SIM card—the card connector (i.e., gold area) should be facing outward with the bevelled corner facing away.

- 5. Lower the SIM card holder down.
- 6. Slide SIM card holder to the right to lock into place. 7. Reinstall battery pack.

Enter Your PIN

After installing the SIM card activate your mobile service connection. In most cases, SIM cards are preset with a PIN (Personal Identity Number), provided by your service provider.

- 1. Press the Power button to turn on the MC55.
- 2. Tap Start > Phone.
- 3. Enter the PIN from your service provider.


Turn On the Phone Function


- 1. Launch the Wireless Manager application
- On the Today screen, tap the Wireless Manager icon.
- On the Today screen, tap the signal icon \(\frac{\mathbf{Y}}{\times}\) and select Wireless Manager.
- 2. On the Wireless Manager screen, tap Phone to turn on the phone function. The signal icon $\dot{Y}_{\mathbf{x}}$ changes indicating the MC55 is searching for a mobile connection. This may take a few seconds. The signal icon Y! changes to Y. and to noce a mobile connection is established.


Turn Off the Phone Function

- 1. Launch the Wireless Manager application.
- On the Today screen, tap the Wireless Manager icon.
- On the Today screen, tap the signal icon and select Wireless Manager.
- 2. On the Wireless Manager screen, tap Phone to turn off phone function.





MicroSD Card Installation


- 1. Remove battery pack. 2. Slide SIM card holder to the left.
- 3. Lift card holder.
- 4. Lift microSD card holder.
- 5. Insert microSD card into card holder.


The proper position of the microSD card—the card connector (i.e., gold area) should be facing inward.

- 6. Close the microSD card holder.
- 7. Close the SIM card holder.




- 8. Slide the SIM card holder to the right to lock
- 9. Reinstall battery pack.







Single-slot USB Cradle Four-slot Charge Only Cradle










- Acquiring satellite signals may take a few minutes. It is best to be outside and have a clear, unobstructed view of the sky.
- Without a clear view, acquisition takes much longer and could result in the MC55 being unable to compute the initial position quickly.
- Obtain a satellite fix before moving.
- Shutdown GPS application when not in use.





AVOID EXTREME WRIST ANGLES
