#### **5 DESCRIPTION OF TEST MODES**

To investigate the maximum EMI emission characteristics generates from EUT, the test system was pre-scanning tested base on the consideration of following EUT operation mode or test configuration mode which possible have effect on EMI emission level. Each of these EUT operation mode(s) or test configuration mode(s) mentioned above was evaluated respectively.

The Transmitter was operated in the normal operating mode. The TX frequency was fixed which was for the purpose of the measurements.

Test of channel included the lowest and middle and highest frequency to perform the test, then record on this report.

Those data rates (1Mbps for GFSK modulation; 2Mbps for  $\pi$ /4-DQPSK modulation; 3Mbps for 8-DPSK modulation) were used for all test.

The EUT was pretested with 3 orientations placed on the table for the radiated emission measurement -X, Y, and Z-plane. The X-plane results were found as the worst case and were shown in this report.





#### 7.1.4 Test Procedure

According to the requirements in Section 13.1.4.1 of ANSI C63.10-2013 Conducted emissions the EUT measured in the frequency range between 0.15 MHz and 30 MHz using CISPR Quasi-Peak and average detector mode.

- 1. The EUT was placed 0.4 meter from the conducting wall of the shielding room.
- 2. The EUT was placed on a table which is 0.8m above ground plane.
- 3. Connect EUT to the power mains through a line impedance stabilization network (LISN). All other support equipments powered from additional LISN(s). The LISN provide 50 Ohm/ 50uH of coupling impedance for the measuring instrument.
- 4. Interconnecting cables that hang closer than 40 cm to the ground plane shall be folded back and forth in the center forming a bundle 30 to 40cm long.
- 5. I/O cables that are not connected to a peripheral shall be bundled in the center. The end of the cable may be terminated, if required, using the correct terminating impedance. The overall length shall not exceed 1 m.
- 6. LISN at least 80 cm from nearest part of EUT chassis.
- 7. The frequency range from 150KHz to 30MHz was searched.
- 8. Set the test-receiver system to Peak Detect Function and specified bandwidth(IF bandwidth=9KHz) with Maximum Hold Mode
- 9. For the actual test configuration, please refer to the related Item –EUT Test Photos.




#### (a) For radiated emissions below 30MHz

#### 7.2.5 Test Procedure

The test site semi-anechoic chamber has met the requirement of NSA tolerance 4 dB according to the standards: ANSI C63.10-2013. The test distance is 3m. The setup is according to the requirements in Section 13.1.4.1 of ANSI C63.10-2013 and CAN/CSA-CEI/IEC CISPR 22.

This test is required for any spurious emission that falls in a Restricted Band, as defined in Section 15.205. It must be performed with the highest gain of each type of antenna proposed for use with the EUT. Use the following spectrum analyzer settings:

- b. The EUT was placed on the top of a rotating table 0.8 m for below 1GHz and 1.5m for above 1GHz the ground at a 3 meter. The table was rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation.
- c. The height of the equipment or of the substitution antenna shall be 0.8 m for below 1GHz and 1.5m for above 1GHz; the height of the test antenna shall vary between 1 m to 4 m. Both horizontal and vertical polarizations of the antenna are set to make the measurement.
- d. For the radiated emission test above 1GHz: Place the measurement antenna away from each area of the EUT determined to be a source of emissions at the specified measurement distance, while keeping the measurement antenna aimed at the source of emissions at each frequency of significant emissions, with polarization oriented for maximum response. The measurement antenna may have to be higher or lower than the EUT, depending on the radiation pattern of the emission and staying aimed at the emission source for receiving the maximum signal. The final measurement antenna elevation shall be that which maximizes the emissions. The measurement antenna elevation for maximum emissions shall be restricted to a range of heights of from 1 m to 4 m above the ground or reference ground plane.
- e. The initial step in collecting conducted emission data is a spectrum analyzer peak detector mode pre-scanning the measurement frequency range. Significant peaks are then marked and then Quasi Peak detector mode re-measured.
- f. If the Peak Mode measured value compliance with and lower than Quasi Peak Mode Limit, the EUT shall be deemed to meet QP Limits and then no additional QP Mode measurement performed.
- g. For the actual test configuration, please refer to the related Item -EUT Test Photos.






#### (1Mbps) Channel Separation plot on channel 77-78




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
(3Mbps) Channel Separation plot on channel 00-01




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

Package Transfer Time Plot CH39-DH1




20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 00 (1Mbps)




# 20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 39 (1Mbps)




# 20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 78 (1Mbps)







20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 00 (2Mbps)

# 20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 39 (2Mbps)






# 20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 78 (2Mbps)







20dB Bandwidth plot on channel 00 (3Mbps)


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
# Peak output Power plot on channel 39 (1Mbps)




# Peak output Power plot on channel 78 (1Mbps)




Peak output Power plot on channel 00 (2Mbps)




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


Peak output Power plot on channel 00 (3Mbps)

RBW = 100KHz

VBW = 300KHz

Band edge emissions must be at least 20 dB down from the highest emission level within the authorized band as measured with a 100kHz RBW. The attenuation shall be 30 dB instead of 20 dB when RMS conducted output power procedure is used.

Measure the highest amplitude appearing on spectral display and set it as a reference level. Plot the graph with marking the highest point and edge frequency.

Repeat above procedures until all measured frequencies were complete.












8-DPSK: Band Edge-Low Channel



- e) Sweep time = auto couple.
- f) Trace mode = max hold.
- g) Allow trace to fully stabilize.

h) Use the peak marker function to determine the maximum amplitude level. Then the limit shall be attenuated by at least 20 dB relative to the maximum amplitude level in 100 kHz.

#### 7.9.6 Test Results

Remark: The measurement frequency range is from 9KHz to the 10th harmonic of the fundamental frequency. The lowest, middle and highest channels are tested to verify the spurious emissions and bandege measurement data.

The worst mode is GFSK mode, and the report only show the worst mode data.

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


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
