**IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

- Read these instructions.
- Keep these instructions.
- Heed all warnings.
- Follow all instructions.
- Do not use this apparatus near water.
- Clean only with dry cloth.
- Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong is provided for your safety. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.
- Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.
- Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.

**Charge**

Insert the included power cable to charge the unit. The charging icon will be on in the display when charging.

Notes: The unit can be used with the power cable while it simultaneously charges the battery. When four charging indicators light up, indicates that the battery is fully charged. When the red indicator flashes, it indicates that the battery is low and needs to be recharged. To save power, when the speaker is not in use, always turn the power switch to the "0" position.



**Bluetooth connect**



- Turn the power switch to the "I" position.
- The Bluetooth icon in the display will start blinking rapidly.
- Active the Bluetooth function on your device and search Bluetooth devices, and select "Blackweb PAR A014" to start connecting.
- Once paired, the Bluetooth icon in the display will turn on steadily, and you will hear "Bluetooth Connected".
- Play music on your device paired and connected with the speaker.

During music play:


- Turn the right Master volume knob to adjust volume.
- Press **||** to pause or resume music play.
- Press **⏮** to skip to the previous/next song.

Notes: This speaker supports automatic connection with a previously paired device after power-off and power-on again. To pair with a new Bluetooth device or connect a previously paired device, first hold **⏮** to disconnect the current Bluetooth device, and then repeat the above step 3.

**AUX**

Use a 3.5mm cable (not included) to connect the speaker to another audio source. Play and control music on your audio device, and use the volume knob on the speaker to adjust volume if necessary.

Notes: In AUX mode, **⏮** **⏭** can't be controlled.



**FM**


- Press FM to turn on FM radio sound source
- Press **⏮** **⏭** repeatedly to tune to a station step by step.
- Hold **⏮** **⏭** to tune to a station automatically.
- Or Sing along with the Microphone with the music played with Bluetooth, AUX or FM station.
- Turn the MIC/GUITAR knob to adjust volume.

**To program FM radio station**

- Hold **||** 2 seconds to search and program available stations.
- LED display will show the program numbers such as: P\_1 or P\_2 ... P\_10(Max)
- Tune to a station with **⏮** **⏭** and then press **||** to assign above program number to it. When successfully, the LED display will show "SAVE".
- Short press **||** to select the corresponding station in your program list.

Notes: The speaker will remember the last station it was on and start at that station when powered off and on again.


**MIC/GUITAR**



- Connect your Microphone(not included) or Guitar(not included) to the MIC/Guitar socket.
- Play Guitar through the speaker.
- Or Sing along with the Microphone with the music played with Bluetooth, AUX or FM station.
- Turn the MIC/GUITAR knob to adjust the Microphone or Guitar volume.

Connect your device's charge cable through the 5V 1A charging socket while the unit's power is turned on.

Notes: To charge smartphones and tablets faster, put the device's screen to sleep.



**Light Mode**



- Hold **☀** to turn on / turn off the light mode.
- Short press **☀** repeatedly to select 5 available display modes.
