Label size

Since there is no engineer assigned to this job, I spoke to Mr. Errol Chang of your FCC office regarding my label size problem. He suggested that I explain it in a letter and submit it as an attachment.

The original submission, June 23<sup>rd</sup>, EA94626, showed two labels, each 3/8"x 2 3/16", on the rear of the transmitter. We are limited to that size because of the printable area. The intent was that one label includes the manufacturer information and the other label includes all of the FCC Part 15 information.

After trying to create the artwork for this label, we discovered that we cannot fit all of the FCC Part 15 information on the back of the transmitter. We would like to put the FCC Part 15 statement in the owner's manual.

So we would like to submit for FCC Certification with the following.

1. Attachment 1: Manufacturer information with FCC ID that we intend to use on the transmitter.
2. Attachment 2: FCC label that does not fit. This statement will be in owner's manual.
3. Attachment 3: FCC label position and location on transmitter.
4. Attachment 4: New instructions page showing FCC statement.
