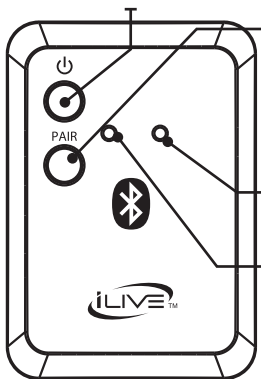


### Power Button

### Pair Button

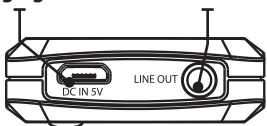
Press to pair.

Status	Indicator

Status	Indicator
Searching	Slowly flashing light
Pairing Mode	Quickly flashing light
Paired	Solid light

### Charging

1. Connect the included Micro USB to USB charging cable to the **Micro USB Charging Port** on the unit and the USB port on a computer or other charging device.

*The device will now charge.*

*Note: Initial charging time 2.5 hours. Please charge fully before use.*

### Connecting

1. Connect the included 3.5 mm cable to the **Line Out** port on the unit and the Line In port on your device.
2. Press the **Power Button** to power the unit on.

*Note: Make sure the unit is fully charged before use.*

### Pairing

1. Press the **Power Button**.
2. The **Pair Indicator** will flash slowly when searching, then quickly to enter pairing mode. If this does not occur, press the **Pair** button.
3. Using the native controls on your Bluetooth device, select the "IAB13" to pair.

*If your device requests a password, enter the default password "0000".*

*Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.*

4. Press the **Power Button** to turn off and disconnect the IAB13B.
