User's Guide for Model JB179B v2344-01



## Important Safety Instructions

- Read these Instructions.
- Keep these Instructions.
- Heed all Warnings.
- Follow all instructions.
- Do not use this apparatus near water.
- Clean only with a dry cloth.
- Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding - type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong are provided for your safety. When the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.
- Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.

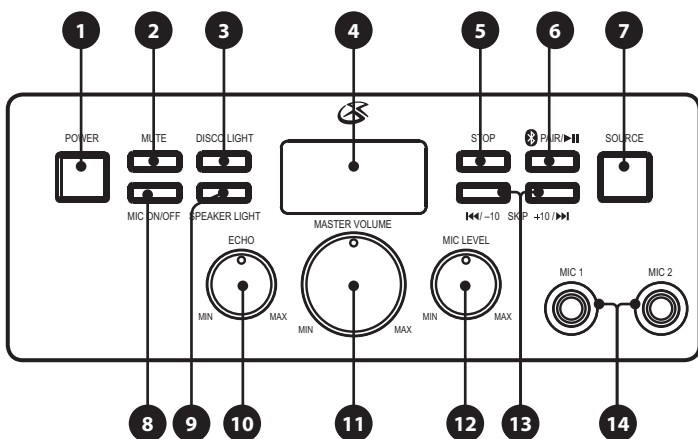

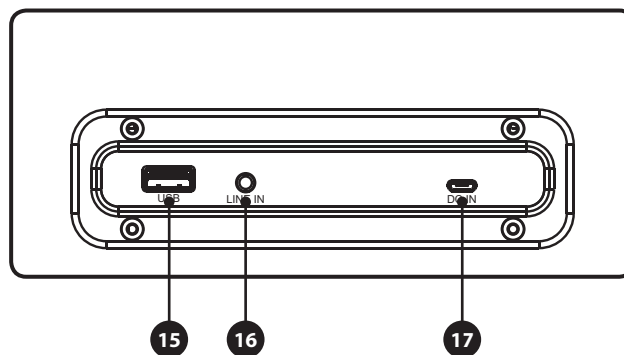

### Controls & Inputs

1. **Power ON/OFF**
2. **Mute**

6. **Pair / Play/Pause**: Press and hold to pair to a Bluetooth device. Press to play or pause tracks (BLUETOOTH/USB).
7. **Source**: Press to change play mode: Bluetooth/Line In/USB.
8. **Mic ON/OFF**
9. **Speaker Light ON/OFF**
10. **Mic Echo Adjust**
11. **Master Volume Adjust**
12. **Mic Volume Adjust**
13. **Navigation**: Short press to skip audio tracks (BLUETOOTH/USB). Press and hold to skip 10 tracks (USB).
14. **Mic Inputs**
15. **USB Media Port**
16. **Line In (3.5mm audio input)**
17. **Micro-USB DC Power Input**

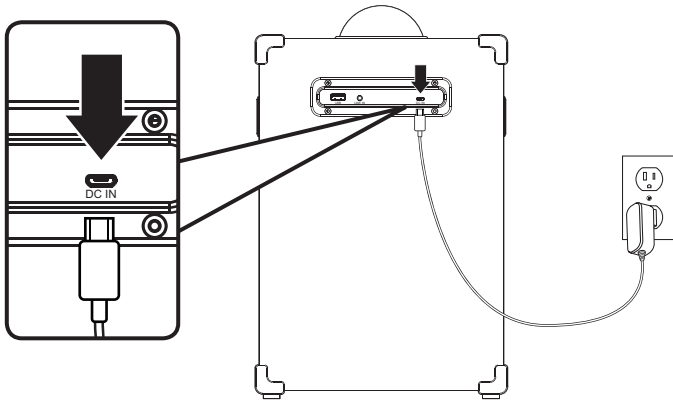

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## Power

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To power the karaoke machine, plug the USB power adapter (included) into the DC Power Input on the speaker and a standard power outlet.




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## Bluetooth Wireless

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### Pairing & Playing Audio

1. When the speaker first powers ON it defaults to Bluetooth Mode and is ready to pair automatically. When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the Bluetooth device.
2. Using the controls on your Bluetooth device, select **JB179B** in the Bluetooth Settings to pair. If need be, refer to the user's manual for your specific device for more information.
3. When successfully paired, a voice will announce, "Bluetooth is connected." Your Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speaker.
4. Use the controls on the connected Bluetooth device to select and play audio. Use the speaker controls or the connected Bluetooth device to play, pause, and adjust the volume level.

After initial pairing, the speaker will automatically connect to the last Bluetooth device used whenever it is in Bluetooth Mode. **Note:** If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, press & hold the  button to enter to Pairing Mode. A voice will announce, "Bluetooth is connecting," and you can connect to the speaker manually.

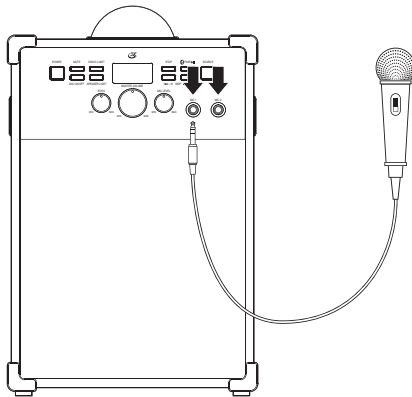
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## Microphone

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Requires a microphone with 1/4 in. input (included).

1. Connect a microphone to either of the **Mic Inputs** on the unit. Whenever a microphone is plugged in, it will transmit audio in addition to other sources that may be playing.
2. Before use, be sure the Mic ON/OFF switches on the microphone and the speaker are in the ON position. Use the Mic Volume and Echo controls to adjust the microphone audio levels.

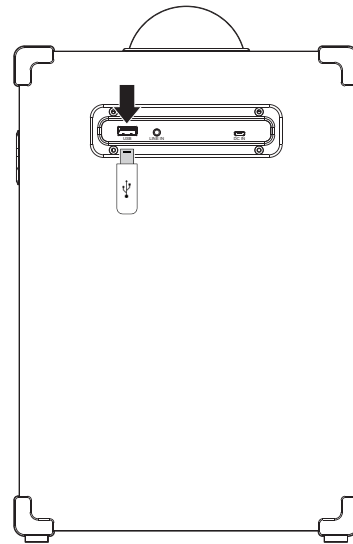


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## USB

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1. Load a USB drive into the USB Media port. The speaker will automatically switch to USB Mode, indicated on the display, and begin playing media on the drive.
2. Use the controls on the speaker to select and play audio from the connected drive.



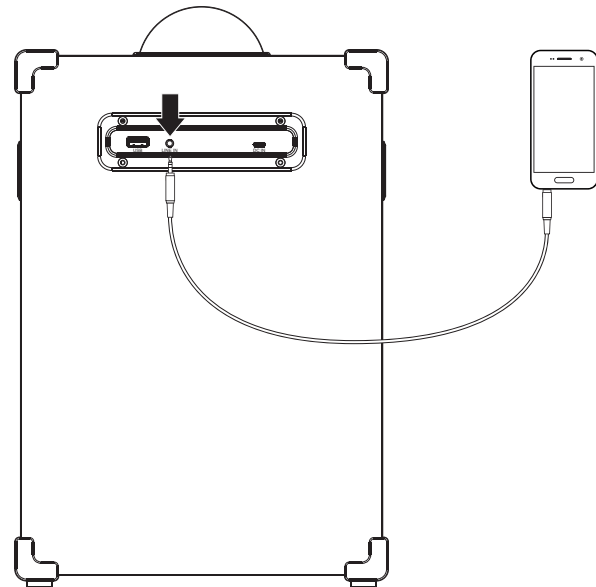
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## Line In

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Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (not included).

1. Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the **Line In** on the unit and the **audio output/headphone jack** on an audio device.
2. Press **Source** to switch to **Line In Mode**.
3. Use the controls on the connected device to select and play audio. Be sure the volume on your connected device is audible when you begin playing.
