

POWER & CHARGING


DC Power Input

Requires an AC/DC power adapter (included).

Each speaker must be charged independently.

Battery life when not in use is roughly 6 months. The battery must then be fully recharged. Charge each speaker for at least 2.5 hours before use.

 Connect one end of the included AC/DC power adaptor to the unit and one end to an AC power outlet to recharge the battery.



WIRELESS CONNECTIONS

Pairing the Speakers

This process should be done **FIRST** before pairing to a Bluetooth device. This should only need to be done upon first use. Make sure the speakers are fully charged before beginning the pairing process.

- 1. Power on the speakers by **sliding the power switch to the ON position** on both units.
- The Bluetooth Indicator and Speaker Connection Indicator will flash slowly in unison. If the Speaker Connection Indicator is not flashing, but is solid white both speakers your speakers are already paired. You can skip to the Pairing a Bluetooth Device section.
- Press the Connect Speakers button on both speakers simultaneously.
- 4. The Speaker Connection Indicators will flash quickly.
- 5. Wait until both Speaker Connection Indicators are **solid white**. This indicates that the speakers have successfully paired. Please note that this process can take up to 1 minute.

For all future uses please turn on both speakers and wait for them to connect. Note that it may take up to 1 minute for them to pair automatically even after initial use, but here should be no need to press Connect Speaker button again. If any pairing issues should occur, repeat the above steps.

Pairing to a Bluetooth Device

Make sure you have first followed the instructions for Pairing the Speakers. When pairing, the device should remain within 3 feet of the speakers.

- 1. Press the **Pair** button on **ONLY ONE** of the speakers. *The pair indicator will begin flashing quickly.*
- Using the native controls on your Bluetooth device, select BWA15AV107 in your Bluetooth settings to pair. If your device requests a password, enter the default password 0 0 0 0.
 - Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.
- When successfully paired, the pairing indicator will stop flashing and will remain solid.
- After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device.

If your device should become unpaired for any reason, repeat the above steps.

If any pairing issues should occur, un-pair the unit on your Bluetooth device and repeat the above steps.

Note: If two speakers with the BWA15AV107 name appear on the pairing list of your device, please erase one of BWA15AV107 listed in your Bluetooth device and repeat the above steps.

Playing Audio Wirelessly

Follow the instructions for Pairing a Bluetooth Device.

- 1. Use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device to select and play, pause or skip media.
- 2. Any audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speakers.
