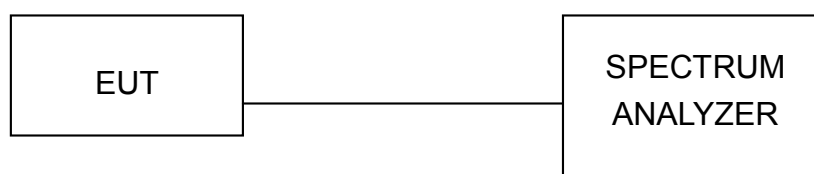
### 5.3.3 TEST PROCEDURE

The transmitter output was connected to the spectrum analyzer through an attenuator. The bandwidth of the fundamental frequency was measured by spectrum analyzer with 100kHz RBW and 100kHz VBW. The 6dB bandwidth is defined as the total spectrum the power of which is higher than peak power minus 6dB.

3. Adjusted the power to have the same reading on oscilloscope. Record the power level.

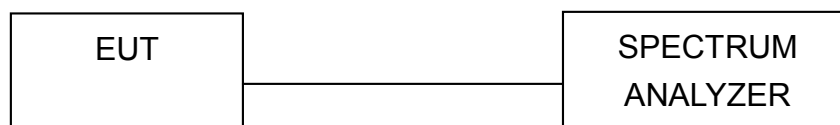
The transmitter output was connected to the spectrum analyzer through an attenuator, the bandwidth of the fundamental frequency was measured with the spectrum analyzer using 3 kHz RBW and 30 kHz VBW, set sweep time = span/3 kHz. The power spectral density was measured and recorded.

The sweep time is allowed to be longer than span/3 kHz for a full response of the mixer in the spectrum analyzer.
