I have a few comments on this Application.

- 1 The Block diagram does not adequately show the transmitter. Please provide a Block Diagram of the transmitter portion of the PDA.
- 2 Please explain what material the label is made of and how it is affixed to the product.
- 3 Please note that the MPE documentation states, "... But it is recommended to always keep, at least, 2.5cm separation distance with the antenna." In another section of the MPE report you state, "Warning statement to the user for keeping at least 20cm or more separation distance with the antenna should be included in users manual." These are conflicting statements. The manual, however, does not contain a caution to keep a separation distance from the body. Please correct all documentation to be consistent by adding the 2.5cm caution to the manual and by correcting the recommended 20cm separation in the MPE report.
- 4 Please note that the MPE report is states that because the manual is to have a 20cm separation caution statement, that the device is portable. This is not accurate. Please correct the documentation to properly identify the device as portable. MPE distances and references must be consistent throughout the application.
